COUNCIL NOMINATION TO THE BERNESLAI HOMES BOARD

1. <u>Purpose of Report</u>

1.1 A vacancy has arisen for a Council nomination to the Board of Berneslai Homes due to Councillor Wilde passing away in July.

2. <u>Recommendation</u>

2.1 To approve the nomination of Councillor T Sheard to the Berneslai Homes Board with immediate effect.

3. Introduction

- 3.1 In accordance with the Berneslai Homes Memorandum of Articles and Association the Council has three Member representatives on the Berneslai Homes Board. Our representatives were Councillors Ennis, Franklin and Wilde. However, Councillor Wilde sadly passed away in July, leaving a vacancy on the Board. The Council has therefore sought nominations from all Councillors.
- 3.2 It is a requirement of the Berneslai Homes Memorandum of Articles and Association that all potential Board Members must undergo a "threshold interview" to ensure they meet the essential criteria and have the skills set required to undertake the role of a non executive director. Once applicants have passed the threshold the Council is then able to consider its appointment.
- 3.4 Following the Council's request for nominations Berneslai Homes received 1 application and the threshold interview took place on 22nd August. Councillor T Sheard fully met the threshold and the panel are satisfied in recommending Councillor T Sheard as nomination to the Council.
- 3.5 Councillor T Sheard would commence on the Board with immediate effect.

4. <u>Consideration of Alternative Approaches</u>

4.1 There are no alternative approaches for consideration as it is a requirement of the Memorandum and Articles of Association that the Board has a balance of representatives from Independent members, Council nominees and Tenants representatives. The Memorandum and Articles of Association were agreed by the Council and it has determined how an appropriate balance of member representation to the Berneslai Homes Board should be maintained.

5.1 The agreed process for the nomination of Council representatives to the Board of Berneslai Homes has been followed. Following the notification to the Council that Council member vacancies had arisen application for the position was received. The threshold interview was conducted, as required, and having met the essential criteria it is recommended that Councillor T Sheard be approved as the nomination from the Council to the Berneslai Homes Board.
