RESOLVED that:-

the proposal and to submit the order for confirmation by the Secretary of State or to confirm it himself in the event of there being no objections thereto; and,

(iii) the Assistant Chief Executive, Legal and Governance, be authorised to make a Definitive Map Modification Order to make the necessary changes to the Definitive Map and Statement for the area.

41. Permissive Path Agreement on Land at Goldthorpe
