2. Declarations of Pecuniary and Non-Pecuniary Interest

3. <u>Application to vary a Premises Licence - Under the Stars Festival,</u> <u>Land adjacent to Cannon Hall Farm Cafe, Cannon Hall Open Farm,</u> <u>Cawthorne, Barnsley</u>

The Panel considered an application to vary a premises licence in respect of the Under the Stars Festival, land adjacent to Cannon Hall Farm Cafe, Cannon Hall Open Farm, Cawthorne, Barnsley located within rural surroundings and within relatively close proximity to a small number of residential dwellings.

After hearing all the evidence presented including representations made by Interested Parties, the Sub decided that in view of there being no prejudice to the Licensing Objectives, the application to vary the Licence be approved in accordance with the proposals contained within the Operating Schedule and subject to:

- the conditions outlined within the Noise Management/Monitoring Plan detailed within Appendix 4 to the report submitted
- there being no more than two events per year
- the submission of an Event Management Plan and appropriate Risk Assessments to the Local Authority Health and Safety Officer prior to any event taking place
