

**NOTES OF MEETING OF STATUTORY LICENSING REGULATORY
BOARD SUB COMMITTEE**

- 1 **Present:** Councillors C Wraith (Chairman), Saunders and Tattersall together with Councillor Brook (Reserve Member).

2. **Declarations of Pecuniary and Non-Pecuniary Interest**

There were no declarations of pecuniary or non-pecuniary interest from Members in respect of items on the agenda.

3. **Application for a Premises Licence – Pinkfields Festival, Cuckold Carr Farm, Coachgate Lane, Gunthwaite, Penistone**

The Panel considered an application for a premises licence in respect of the Pinkfields Festival, Cuckold Carr Farm, Coachgate Lane, Gunthwaite, Penistone located within rural surroundings and within relatively close proximity to a small number of residential dwellings.

After hearing all the evidence presented including representations made by Interested Parties, the Sub decided that in view of there being no prejudice to the Licensing Objectives, the application to vary the Licence be approved in accordance with the proposals contained within the Operating Schedule detailed within the report and subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The Licensing Activities only to take place under the authority of the Premises Licence on a maximum occasion of one event per calendar year
- (b) Notification to be given to all Responsible Authorities at least 28 days before licensable activities can take place under the authority of this Premises Licence
- (c) Notification to be given to all residents who live within a one mile radius of the site at least 28 days before licensable activities can take place under the authority of this Premises Licence
- (d) The Licensing Authority and, if deemed appropriate, all Responsible Authorities to be allowed to inspect the site the day prior to the start of an event
- (e) The performance of live music and dance to be restricted to 1.30 am and the supply of alcohol to be restricted to 1.30am
- (f) The following Final Plans shall be submitted to the appropriate authorities at least four weeks in advance of an event:
 - i. Event Management Plan and Risk Assessment – to the Council, Health & Safety and South Yorkshire Police
 - ii. Noise Management Plan – to Pollution Control
 - iii. Traffic management Plan – to the Highways Authority

The Premises Licence be granted subject to the Plans being agreed by the authorities as outlined

The decision of the Sub-Committee was unanimous.
