20. <u>Establishment of the Independent Living at Home Service Limited as a Local Authority Trading Company (Cab.2.7.2014/6)</u>

RESOLVED:-

- (i) that approval be given for the establishment of the Independent Living at Home Service Limited as a Local Authority Trading Company (LATC), operating as a wholly owned subsidiary of Barnsley Council, which will require the workforce to TUPE, to best enable the Independent Living at Home Service Limited (ILAHS) to expand its core services across the UK;
- (ii) that the ILAHS submit a further Business Plan for Cabinet approval, to include detailed service transition activities such as Board structure and governance arrangements as part of the development of a new organisational structure;

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- (iii) that the further Business Plan also include consideration as to the contracting arrangements for the provision of integrated re-ablement and assistive living technology services between the Council and the LATC and the length of any such contract; and consideration as to the future profit share arrangements between the Council and the LATC taking into account the Council's medium term financial position; and
- (ii) that submission for both be scheduled for Cabinet on 16th July, 2014.
