# 1. Purpose of Report

#### 3. Background

The Cooper Art Gallery Trust was established in 1913 to administer the Cooper Gallery and Samuel Joshua Cooper's bequest of 275 paintings. The Trust has a permanent collection of 17<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> Century paintings, watercolours and drawings formed almost entirely from the gifts of four benefactors; Samuel Cooper himself, Sir Michael Sadler, Thomas Fox and Roland Addy. The Gallery also holds a regular programme for contemporary art exhibitions.

The Council appoints three representatives as Cooper Art Gallery Trustees. Our current representatives are Councillors Richardson, D. Birkinshaw and Bruff. Councillor Bruff has indicated that she wishes to stand down as a Trustee.

#### 4. Proposal

It is proposed that approval be given to the appointment of a Council representative as a Cooper Art Gallery Trustee to replace Councillor Bruff.
