APPOINTMENT TO BARBERS RELIEF IN NEED CHARITY AND BARBERS SCHOOL CHARITY

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To agree the appointment of a representative to the Barbers Relief in Need Charity and Barbers School Charity.

2. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 **Recommended to Council that approval be given to the appointment of a representative to the Barbers Relief in Need Charity and Barbers School Charity.**

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The Barbers Relief in Need Charity is a charity that provides financial assistance, derived from the interest accumulated from investments made by its founder, to old age groups based in the former Darton UDC area. The assistance is distributed on the basis of the size of the organisation on an annual basis, usually just before Christmas.
- 3.2 The Barbers School Charity provides financial assistance to the 6 schools in the former Darton UDC area when sufficient interest on investments have been accumulated (usually every 5-6 years). The assistance is used for the purchase of equipment.
- 3.3 The charities comprise of 8 Trustees, 3 of which are nominated by Barnsley MBC.

4. CURRENT POSITION

- 4.1 Barnsley MBC's nominated representatives are Councillors Miller and Burgess and there is 1 vacancy.

5. PROPOSAL

- 5.1 It is proposed that approval be given to the appointment of a representative to the Barbers Relief in Need Charity and Barbers School Charity to fill the vacancy.
