## 4. Report from Royston Scrutiny Steering Group

The Chair welcomed Bill Newman Chair of the Royston Scrutiny Steering Group. Notes of the Steering group meeting held on the 9<sup>th</sup> December were distributed and the Chair of the group gave a brief update of the meeting and the work of the Steering group.

A proposal was put forward to support the services of a District Nurse in Royston but it was felt that discussions should be held with the local surgeries on the current services available in Royston, this was agreed.

Concerns were raise at the sustainability of Children's Centres and discussions took place on how services could be developed and delivered supporting the work of the Children's Centre and planning for the future.

**Web Site,** S Croft reported on a meeting with Carlton Community College who were enthusiastic about designing the web site and also about reporting on the work of the Ward Alliance and the projects it commissions. There were questions raised about a number of issues, the independence of the web site, a Domain Name, Hosting Costs, links with Social media and e mail addresses.

It was agreed that S Croft would follow up with the college and the secretary would provide information for inclusion on the web site.
