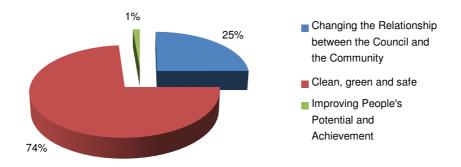
## North East Area Council (April 2013 - March 2014) Update

## **Devolved Ward Budget funding overview**

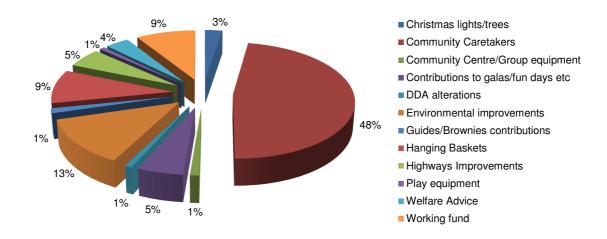
The North East Area Council committed £55,690 of its £80,000 Devolved Ward Budget allocation, with £44,968 of this commitment being charged.

The Cudworth Ward committed £16,376 of its £20,000 Devolved Ward Budget allocation, but had an actual charge of £15,731 charged to the Ward.

The uncharged £4,269 from 2013-2014 will be added to the £20,000 2014-2015 allocation, giving a full Devolved Ward Budget allocation of £24,269.\*

The Royston Ward committed £13,945 of its £20,000 Devolved Ward Budget allocation, but had an actual charge of £6,232 charged to the Ward.

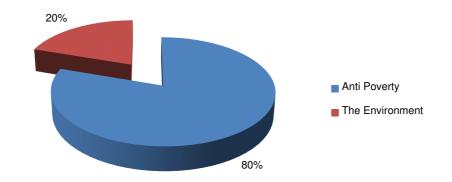

The Cudworth, Monk Bretton and North East Wards did not commit any of their £10,000 Ward Alliance Fund allocation

The uncharged £10,000 from 2013-2014 will be added to the £10,000 2014-2015 allocation, giving each Ward a full Ward Alliance Fund allocation of £20,000\* to spend in the 2014-2015 financial year.

The Royston Ward committed £2,530 of its £10,000 Ward Alliance Fund allocation, with £1,367.50 of this commitment charged to the Ward.

The uncharged £7,470 from 2013-2014 will be added to the £10,000 2014-2015 allocation, giving a full Ward Alliance Fund allocation of £18,632.50\*

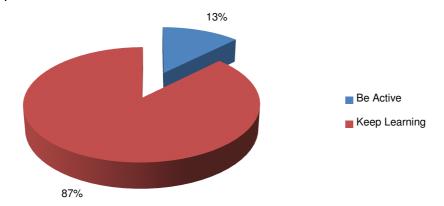
The projects declared a total number of 550 volunteer hours, which equates to the equivalent monetary value of £6,099.50.
