# APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE Soul Lounge/Oxygen, 16-18 Shambles Street, Barnsley S70 2SW

#### 1 Background

- 1.1 On 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2010, under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003, four Temporary Event Notices were submitted by Mr Ali Asgari, 16-18 Shambles Street, Barnsley, S70 2SW. A copy of each application form is attached as Appendix 1.
- 1.2 Members are requested to determine each Temporary Event Notice.
- 1.3 The Soul Lounge and Oxygen is a split premises. The Soul Lounge entrance can be accessed at street level from Shambles Street and Oxygen accessed at basement level from the rear of the premises on Grahams Orchard. The premises is located within Barnsley Town Centre and Mr Asgari is both the premises licence holder and designated premises supervisor.

- 2.6 With reference to the above and as described by the applicant, the nature of the event is to permit the extension of recorded music and dancing.
- 2.7 In accordance with Section 102 (1) of the Licensing Act 2003, the Licensing Authority has a duty to acknowledge receipt of each TEN.

#### 3 Responsible Authorities

- 3.1 On the 24<sup>th</sup> November 2010, Licensing Officer Kirsty Green on behalf of South Yorkshire Police submitted a formal objection notice as a Responsible Authority under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 against the grant of each Temporary Event Notice. The objection notice made was on the grounds of crime and disorder. Full details relating to the objection notice made are contained within Appendix 2.
- 3.2 Members are minded to note that only the Police may object to a Temporary Event Notice, and when doing so this must be based on crime prevention grounds. In accordance with Section 104 (2a) of the Licensing Act 2003, the Licensing Officer of South Yorkshire Police has satisfied this criteria.
- 3.3 Furthermore, it should also be noted that a Licensing Authority cannot attach any conditions, limitations or restrictions to the carrying on of licensable activities in this instance. Licensing Authorities, can, however, give advice on matters such as noise prevention, nuisance, health and safety and any other issues relevant to the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003.

#### 4 Interested Parties

4.1 Under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003, Interested Parties are not invited to make representations.

#### 5 Options Available to Members

- 5.1 In determining each Temporary Event Notice submitted, Section 105 of the Licensing Act 2003 provides that a local authority must, having regard to the objection notice made by Licensing Officer Kirsty Green of South Yorkshire Police, serve the applicant, Mr Asgari, with a counter notice if it considers it necessary for the promotion of the crime prevention objective. In doing so, the Authority must give reasons for the decision made and serve the Police with copies of this decision notice.
- 5.2 Alternatively, in the case where it decides not to serve a counter notice, the Authority must give the applicant, Mr Asgari and Licensing Officer Kirsty Green of South Yorkshire Police, notice of its decision and clearly state reasons for this.
- 5.3 Members are minded to note that if a decision is made to uphold the objection notice and indeed serve a counter notice, this must be issued at least 24 hours before the beginning of the event period specified on each Temporary event Notice.

#### 6 Compatibility with the European Convention on Human Rights

The decision of the Board will amount to a determination of the Council and the rights of the applicant. Therefore, as far as it is possible to do so, the board must comply with the requirements of Article 6 (the write to a fair trial). This means the applicant and should be afforded the right to make oral representations at the meeting.

If Members determine to refuse the application, it is necessary for the reasons to be clearly stated.

Formal objection for Temporary Event Notices taking place on the 11<sup>th</sup> December 2010, 12<sup>Th</sup> December 2010, 18<sup>th</sup> December 2010, 19<sup>th</sup> December 2010, 25<sup>th</sup> December 2010, 26<sup>th</sup> December 2010, 27<sup>th</sup> December 2010 and 1<sup>st</sup> January 2011 at premises known as Oxygen/Soul Lounge.

I wish to formally object on behalf of the Chief Constable of the South Yorkshire Police to the application for Temporary Event Notices in relation to the above premises received 24th November 2010.

The grounds for the objection are made under the crime and disorder reduction objective and the prevention of crime and disorder.

The application relates to a premise, which has attracted a high number of incidents involving public disorder during the last 18 months.

The catalogue of incidents amongst other associated public order offences include robbery, knife crime and grievance bodity harm. In May in light of such incidents at Oxygen, South Yorkshire Police applied for a review of the premises licence.

The District Judge at Rotherham Magistrates Court heard that all incidents related to Oxygen, 70% of which occurred on Sunday mornings of which 75% occurred after 2am. In relation to the violence it was quiet apparent that innocent members of the public were drawn in and harmed.

After considering the evidence the District Judge was satisfied that action needed to be taken and felt it necessary to reduce the opening hours to both Oxygen and the Soul Lounge to 11am – 2am each day, with the supply of alcohol reduced to 11am – 1.30am each day.

With a high concentration of incidents occurring after 2am and a District Judge deeming that the level of crime and disorder was serious enough to reduce their opening hours, I strongly believe that an extension of opening hours should not be permitted.

South Yorkshire Police strongly object to the application on the grounds of crime and disorder and would request a counter notice be issued following any hearing to consider this application.
