Protecting the health of the population by improving the prevention and control of infectious diseases and other environmental threats.


It involves: Ensuring the safety and quality of food, water, air and the general environment. Preventing the transmission of communicable diseases


















Health Protection Board

- Information on all cases of anaphylactic reactions relating to commercial food premises.


