

What We Have Achieved - The Figures

To date.....

- ▶ We have facilitated 260 Twiggs led Social action projects
- Worked with many groups including parish councils/ town council and independent groups on 151 occasions
- Supported 10 New Community Groups
- Worked with local schools 39 times on community based improvement projects
- Worked with local businesses 79 instances to improve and benefit the Penistone area
- Completed 131 litter picks across the 2 wards removing in excess of 340 bags of waste from the streets
- This has meant we have had the pleasure of working alongside 763 adult volunteers and 168 young volunteers
- With a massive 2595 volunteer hours
- Which just on these hours alone creates a social return on investment of over £35'000








