Communications are working well, when requests on behalf of local members and the community the work has been carried out satisfactorily. The Team carried out an Operation in the church street area of Thurnscoe as a result of complaints from Thurnscoe Crime and Safety group. The offender was caught and fixed penalty ticket issued, the alleyway was cleaned up and now the residents have passed on their thanks when I reported back to the group.

School patrols have been carried out as and when required, these have been successful with complimentary approval passed in. Further as a result of a complaint from a community group and local member about a local shopkeeper leaving rubbish items (Plant pots etc) outside the premises on an evening .They were advised and have take on board advice given (On threat of enforcement).

There has been ongoing work carried out in Thurnscoe cemetery. Advice given and posters renewed. Currently an Operation is planned in the Houghton Road, Thurnscoe and Lowfield Road, Bolton.

Several tickets for misuse of disabled parking bays have been handed out at Goldthorpe. Operation carried out to catch lorry drivers littering and urinating on commercial road. (Two caught and tickets issued.)One male is appearing in court for previous offence of fly tipping in Bolton he refused to pay after Berneslai homes complaint. He has been fined £400.

Update regarding Cameras purchased out of Ward Alliance funds

The protocol for the allocation of cameras is that I am contacted either by the local community or local members to request their use. The team have to prioritise in relation to requests for the legal position / physical position regarding suitability / cost and the urgency of request.

The current locations of our cameras are Top of Windsor street at Thurnscoe in relation to community requests regarding Anti-social behaviour. The second is at the rear of Kelly Street with regard to environmental purposes at the request of a local member. The third is positioned on the lamppost outside the horse and Groom in relation to crime/ASB prevention purposes.
