1. Purpose of Report

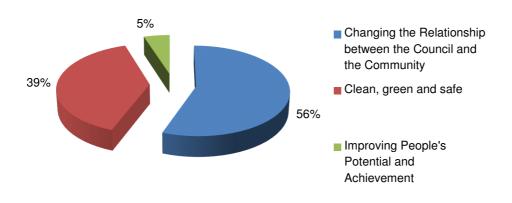

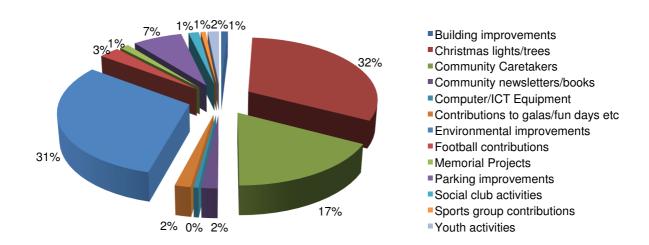

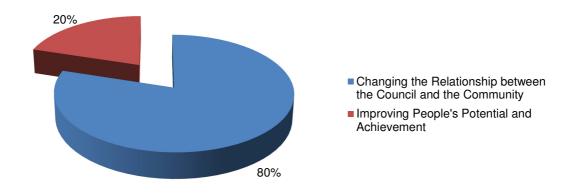

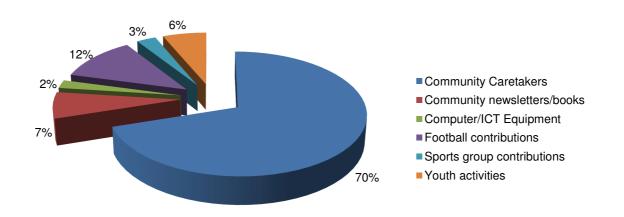

The pie chart below shows the split of how the commitment supports the corporate plan priorities.



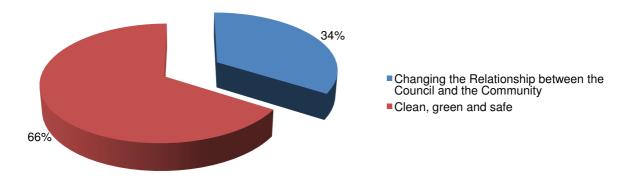
The pie chart below shows the committed spend in the Darfield Ward split into themes



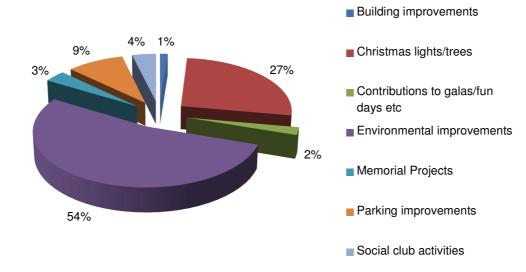

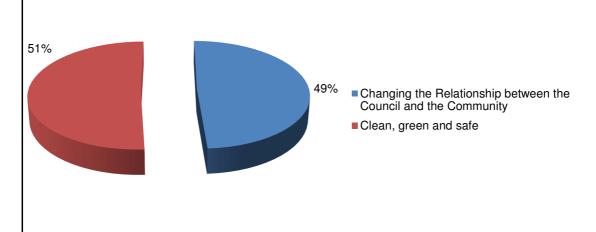
The pie chart below shows the committed spend in the Hoyland Milton Ward split into themes



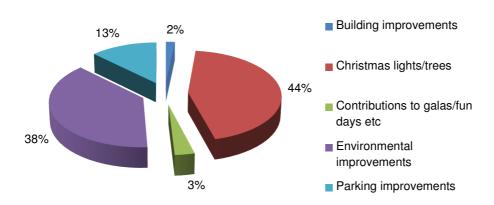

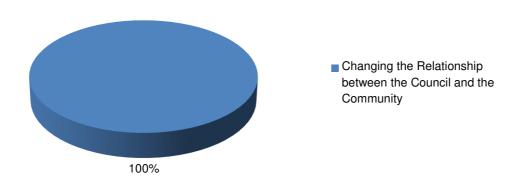
The pie chart below shows the committed spend in the Rockingham Ward split into themes



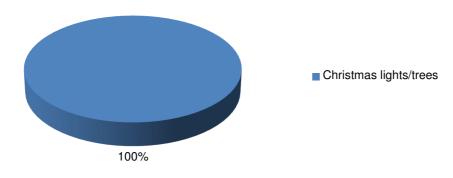

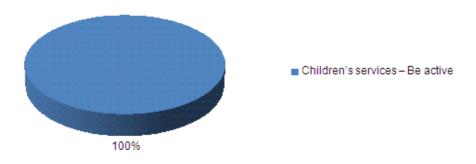
Hoyland Milton, Rockingham and Wombwell have yet to commit any of their allocated Public Health Funding.
