3. Background

A further report providing detail, including the Area Governance Handbook and Terms of Reference for the Area Councils, was submitted to Cabinet on 8th May 2013. In approving the recommendations in the report, Cabinet agreed that Area Councils would formally approve the appointment of community representatives to the Ward Alliances. This report is submitted on that basis.
