# APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE The Cross Keys Filling Station, Sheffield Road, Hoyland Common

#### 1. Background

- 1.1 In February 2008 an application under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 was received from Mr. James Stephen Goodwill for a premises licence for Cross Keys Filling Station. A copy of this application is attached as Appendix 1.
- 1.2 Members are requested to determine the application for the Premises Licence.
- 1.3 The Cross Keys Filling Station is a petrol filling station with an associated retail forecourt store. The applicant is intending to extend the existing store to provide in excess of 700 square feet of retail space serving a range of fresh foods, groceries and other products, together with alcohol if this application is approved.

#### 2 Prohibition of alcohol sales at services areas, garages etc

- 2.1 Section 176 of the Licensing Act 2003 prohibits the sale of alcohol from excluded premises. A copy of this section of the Act is attached as Appendix 2.
- 2.2 Section 176 (2)(b) is applicable in this case and states:

"excluded premises" means......premises used primarily as a garage or which form part of a premises which are primarily so used.

- 2.3 The Section 182 Guidance issued in June 2007 by the Department of Culture Media and Sport (DMCS) clarifies further what should be considered as "primary use". A copy of this guidance is attached as Appendix 3.
- 2.4 As the extension to the premises has not yet taken place, the applicant has provided projected footfall figures and a copy of these are attached at Appendix 4.

#### 3 The Application for a Premises Licence

3.1 On the 15<sup>th</sup> February 2008 an application was made for a Premises Licence for Cross Keys Filling Station, Sheffield Road, Hoyland Common, Barnsley. This application relates to the supply of alcohol The details of which are specified below:

#### a) Supply of Akohol

The premises licence application has been made in respect of the provision of supply of alcohol. The hours requested are for supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises between the hours of 06.00 and 22.00hrs every day.

#### b) Hours Premises are open to the public

The premises licence application has been made to allow the premises to open between the hours of 06.00 and 22.00hrs every day.

#### 4 Promotion of licensing objectives

4.1 The applicant has set out in the application the additional steps intended to be taken in order to promote the four licensing objectives, if the proposed premises licence is granted.

#### a) General - all four licensing objectives

Audible alarm system, CCTV with recording facilities, fully trained staff with on going training regime, Spirits located behind counter area. Challenge 21 and Pass accredited proof of age initiative embraced, refusal book, instore signage.

#### b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Audible alarm system, CCTV with recording facilities, instore signage, spirits located behind counter area.

#### c) Public Safety

Staff trained in fire safety procedures and evacuation procedures, fire safety equipment located on site with staff trained in its use.

#### d) The prevention of public nuisance

Staff trained to deal with situations

#### e) The protection of children from harm

Staff fully trained in alcohol sales with on going refresher training, spirits located behind the counter area. Challenge 21 and pass accredited proof of age scheme, instore signage, refusal book.

#### 5 Responsible Authorities

5.1 No representations have been received from any responsible authorities.

#### 6 Interested parties

- 6.1 Following publication of the statutory notice of the application for the premises licence in the local press and the display of notices at the premises one representation has been received from an interested party.
- 6.2 The representation has been received from Mr Stuart Jackson of the Cross Keys Inn Sheffield Road, Hoyland Common, Barnsley which is a public house located adjacent to the applicants premises. A map of showing the location of the premises is attached at Appendix 6.
- 6.3 The representation made by the interested party relates to the licensing objectives and is attached as Appendix 5.
- 6.4 The representation sets out three areas of concern in relation to the licensing objectives and these are:
  - a) The premises are a fuel filling station, and could encourage normally responsible drivers to take a drink whilst driving.

- b) The above could certainly be applied to the younger inexperienced driver, out to impress his/her partner/friends.
- c) It will be a magnet to the youth of Hoyland Common and Birdwell causing:
  - i) Potential underage drinking
  - ii) Binge drinking
  - iii) Rowdy behaviour
  - iv) Litter
  - v) Groups of youths encouraging underage consumption
  - vi) 18 year olds have both older and younger friends, and would be encouraged into buying alcohol for their younger friends.

#### 7 Compatibility with the European Convention on Human Rights

The decision of the Board will amount to a determination of the Council and the rights of the applicant. Therefore, as far as it is possible to do so, the board must comply with the requirements of Article 6 (the write to a fair trial). This means the applicant and should be afforded the right to make oral representations at the meeting.

If Members determine to refuse the application, it is necessary for the reasons to be clearly stated.

#### Appendix 2

#### Extract from the Licensing Act 2003

Service areas and garages etc.

176 Prohibition of alcohol sales at service areas, garages etc.

- (1) No premises licence, club premises certificate or temporary event notice has effect to authorise the sale by retail or supply of alcohol on or from excluded premises.
- (2) In this section "excluded premises" means-
  - (a) premises situated on land acquired or appropriated by a special road authority, and for the time being used, for the provision of facilities to be used in connection with the use of a special road provided for the use of traffic of class I (with or without other classes); or
  - (b) premises used primarily as a garage or which form part of premises which are primarily so used.
- (3) The Secretary of State may by order amend the definition of excluded premises in subsection (2) so as to include or exclude premises of such description as may be specified in the order.
- (4) For the purposes of this section-
  - (a) "special road" and "special road authority" have the same meaning as in the Highways Act 1980 (c. 66), except that "special road" includes a trunk road to which (by virtue of paragraph 3 of Schedule 23 to that Act) the provisions of that Act apply as if the road were a special road.
  - (b) "class I" means class I in Schedule 4 to the Highways Act 1980 as varied from time to time by an order under section 17 of that Act, but if that Schedule is amended by such an order so as to add to it a further class of traffic, the order may adapt the reference in subsection (2)(a) to traffic of class I so as to take account of the additional class, and
  - (c) premises are used as a garage if they are used for one or more of the following—
    - (i) the retailing of petrol,
    - (ii) the retailing of derv,
    - (iii) the sale of motor vehicles,
    - (iv) the maintenance of motor vehicles.

#### Appendix 3

Extract from Section 182 DCMS Guidance

#### **GARAGES**


5.23 Section 176 of the 2003 Act prohibits the sale or supply of alcohol from premises that are used primarily as a garage, or are part of premises used primarily as a garage. Premises are used as a garage if they are used for one or more of the following:

- the retailing of petrol;
- the retailing of derv;
- the sale of motor vehicles; and
- the maintenance of motor vehicles.
- 5.24 The licensing authority must decide whether or not any premises is used primarily as a garage. The approach endorsed so far by the courts is based on intensity of use to establish primary use. For example, if a garage shop in any rural area is used more intensely by customers purchasing other products than by customers purchasing the products or services listed above, it may be eligible to seek authority to sell or supply alcohol.
- 5.25 Where there is insufficient evidence to establish primary use, it is for the licensing authority to decide whether to grant the licence and deal with any issues through enforcement action or to defer granting the licence until the primary use issue can be resolved to their satisfaction.
