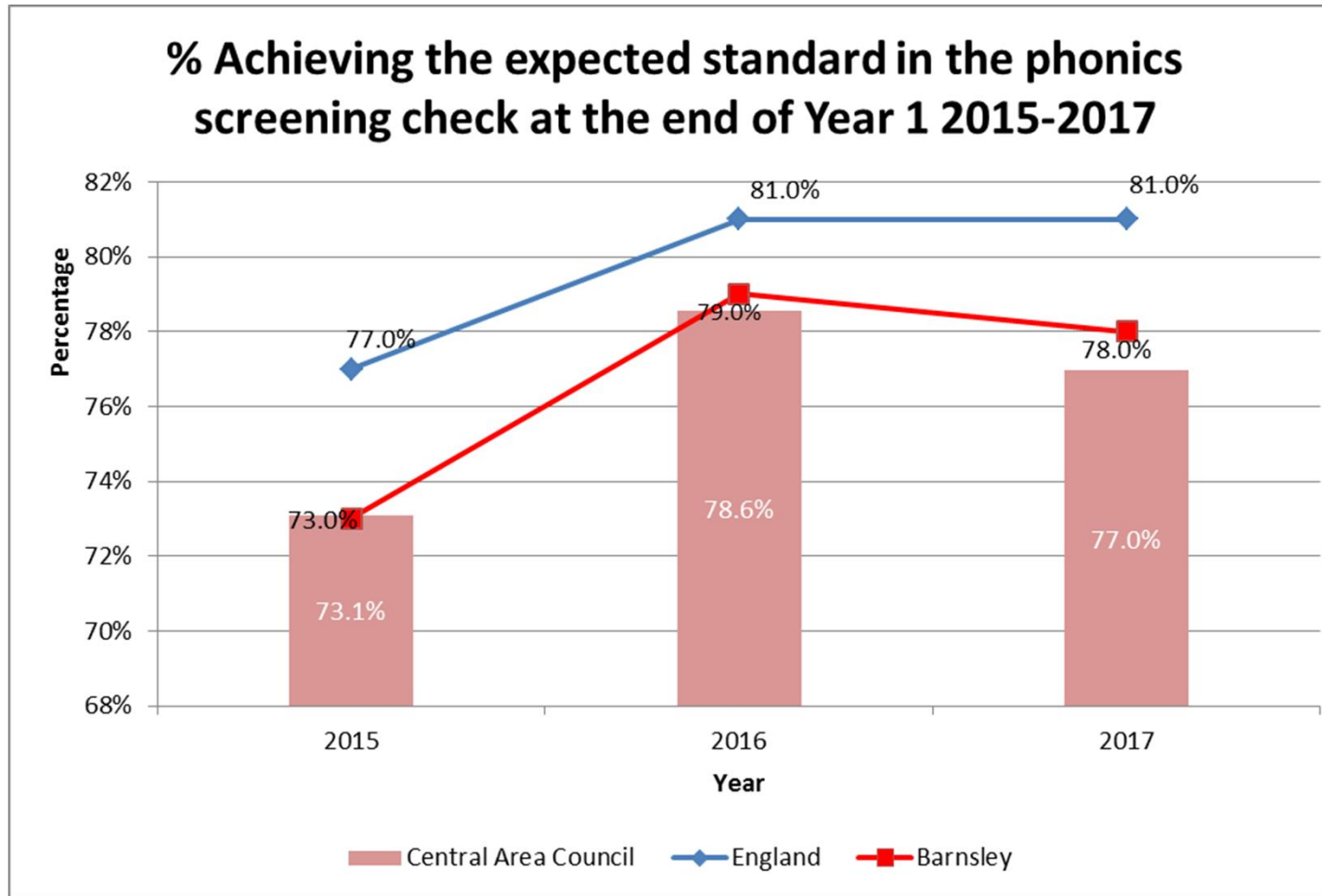


# Education- Early Years Foundation Stage

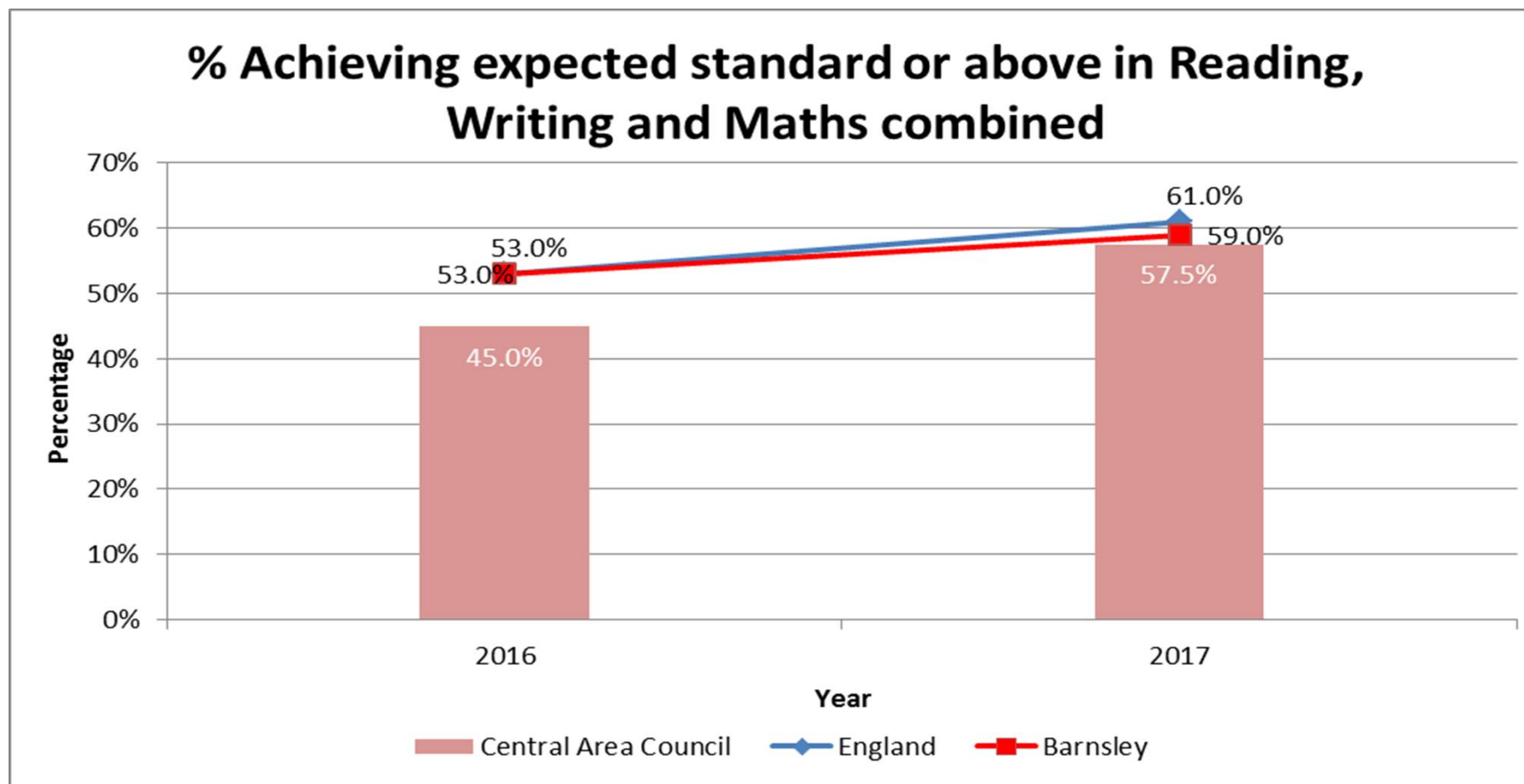




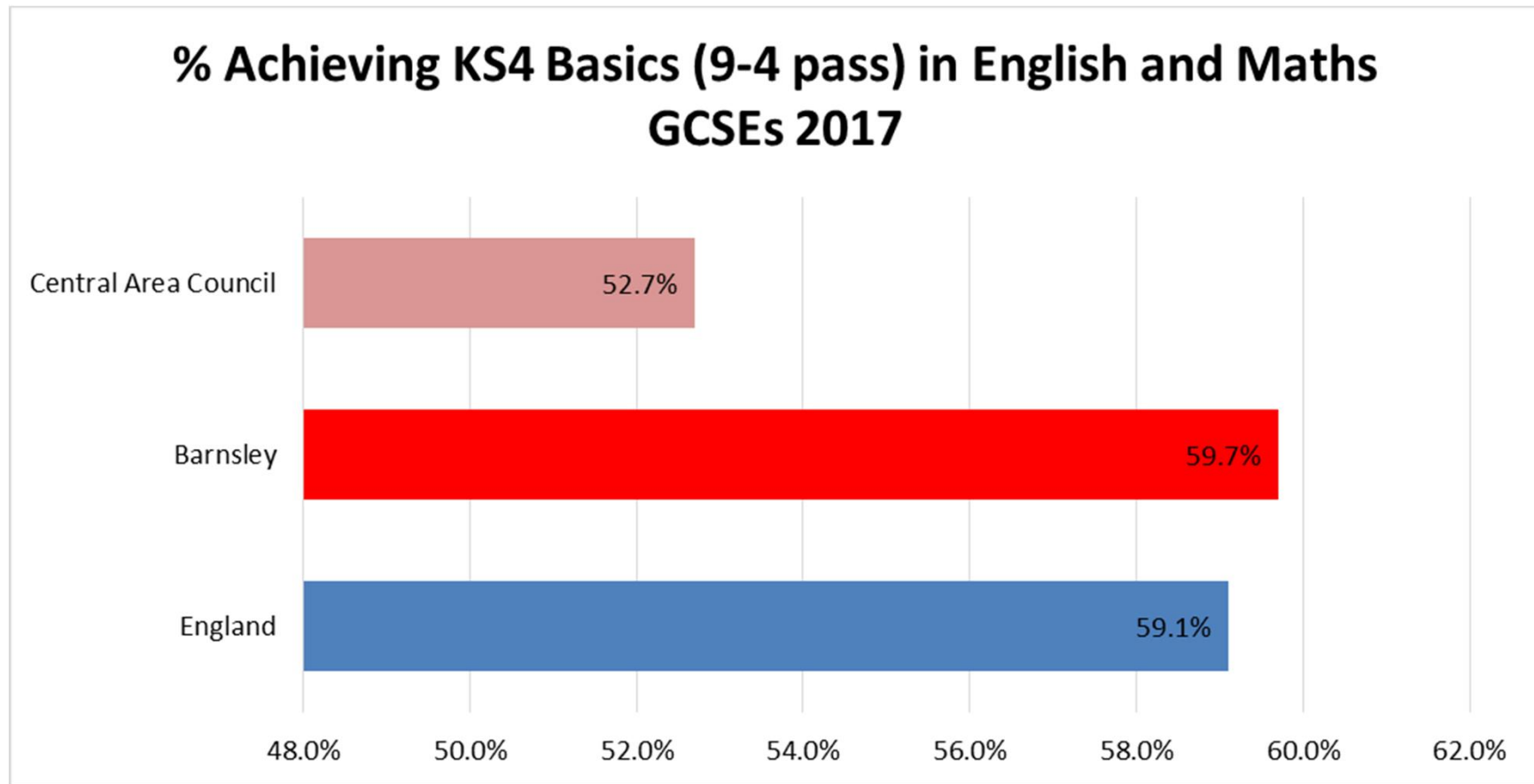

In February 2018:

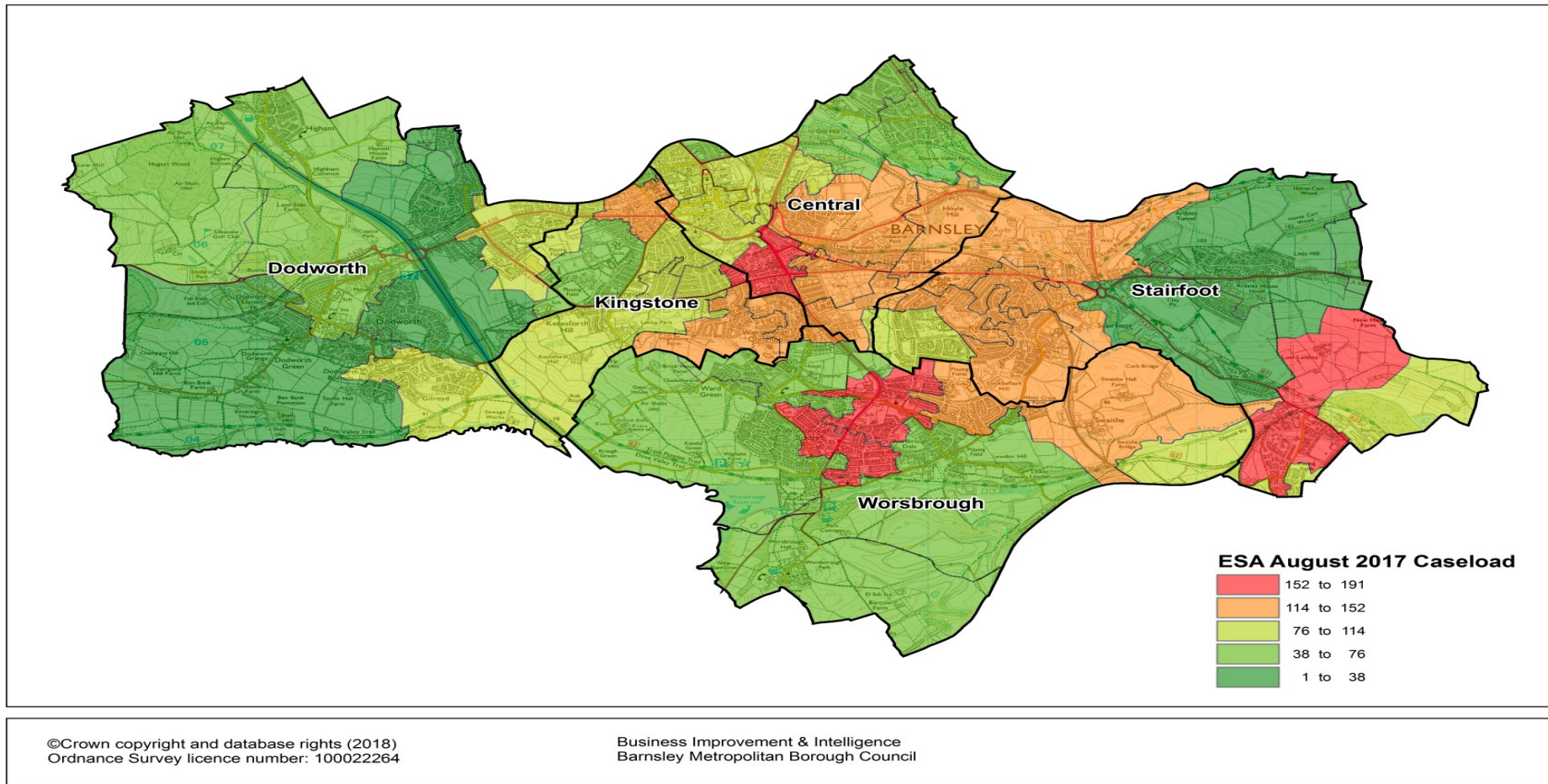
- Central Area Council contained over 1,300 people claiming out of work benefits, this is 3.7% of the population aged 16 to 64 years.

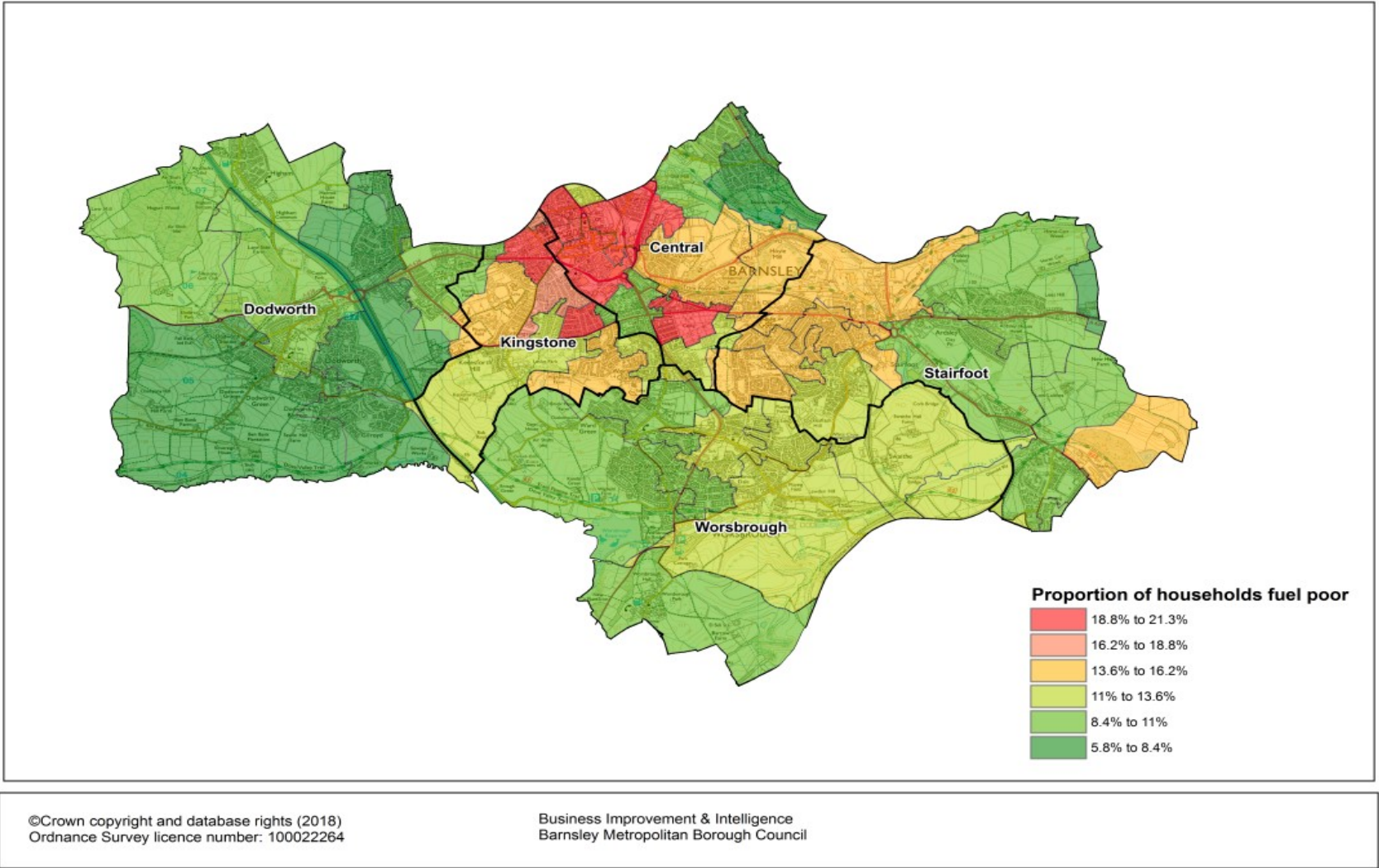

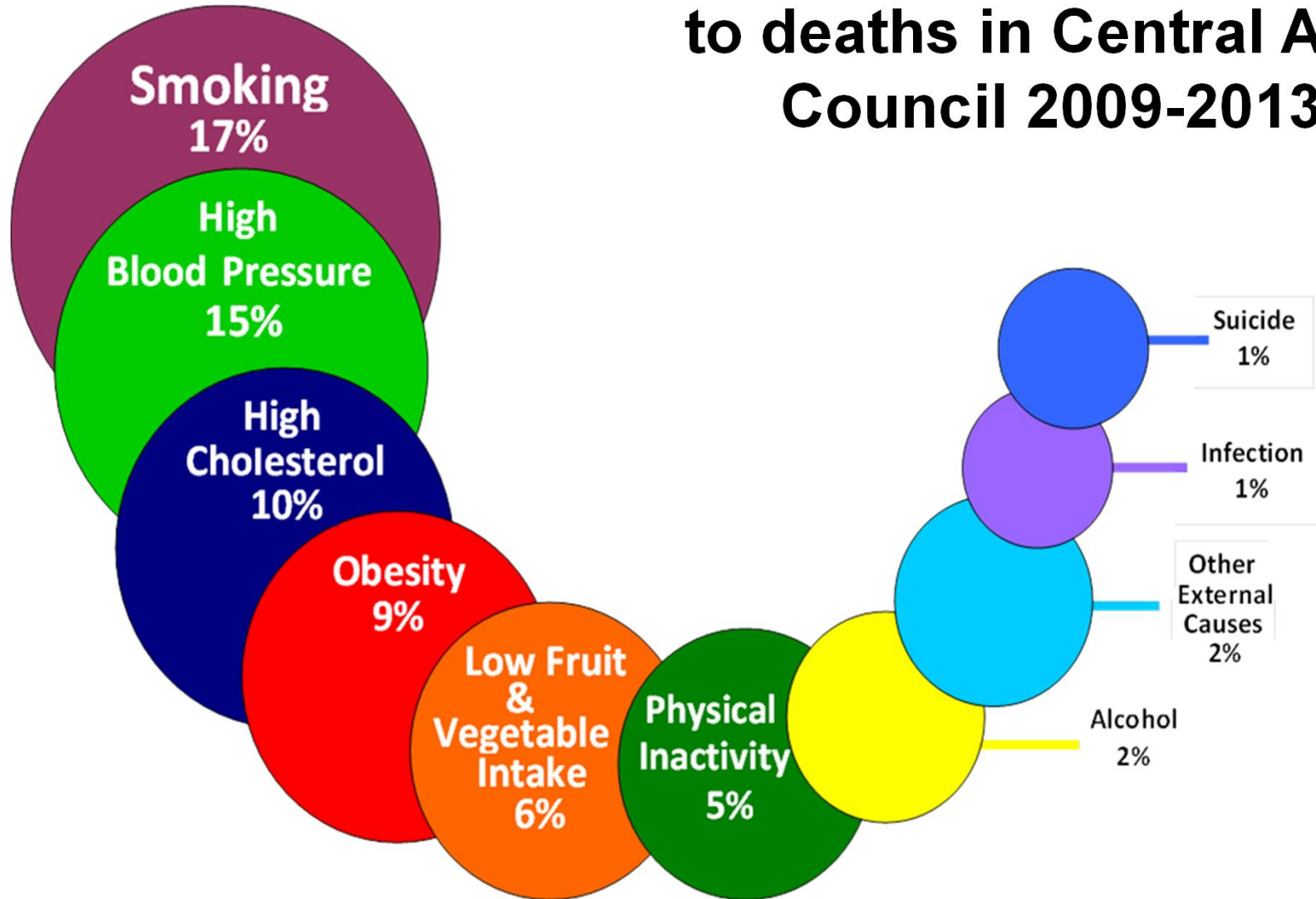

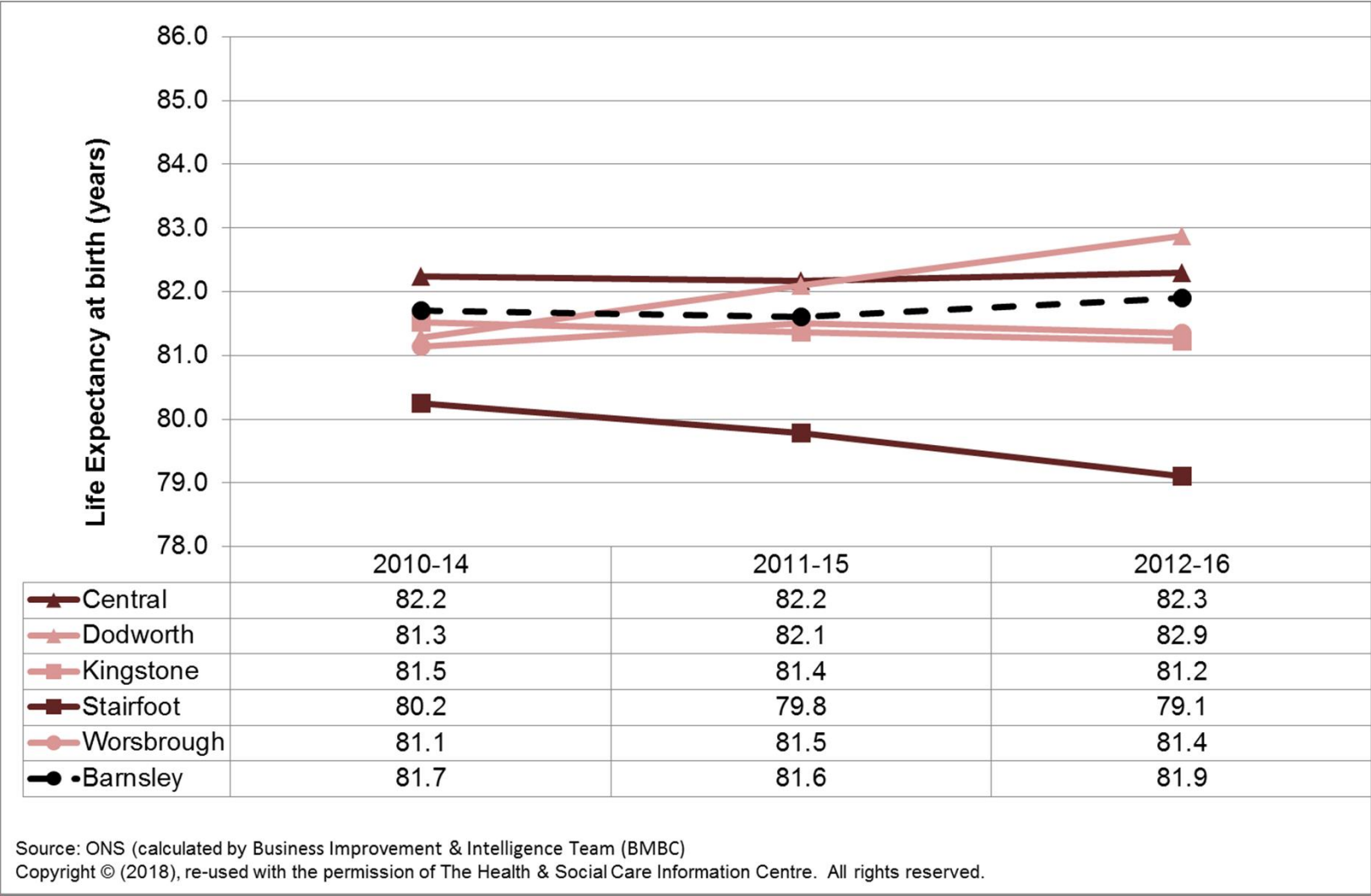
# Risk factors contributing to deaths in Central Area Council 2009-2013

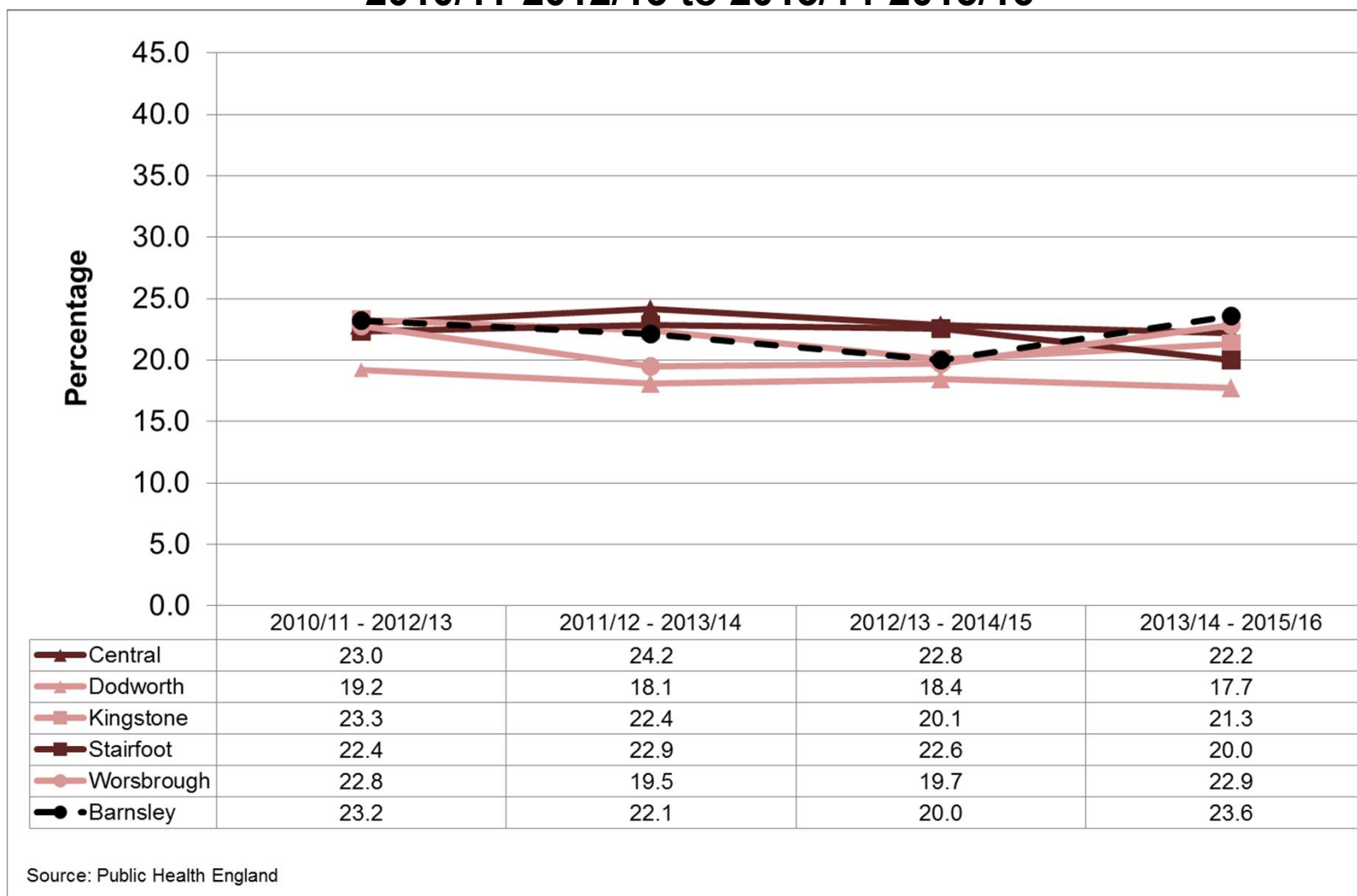

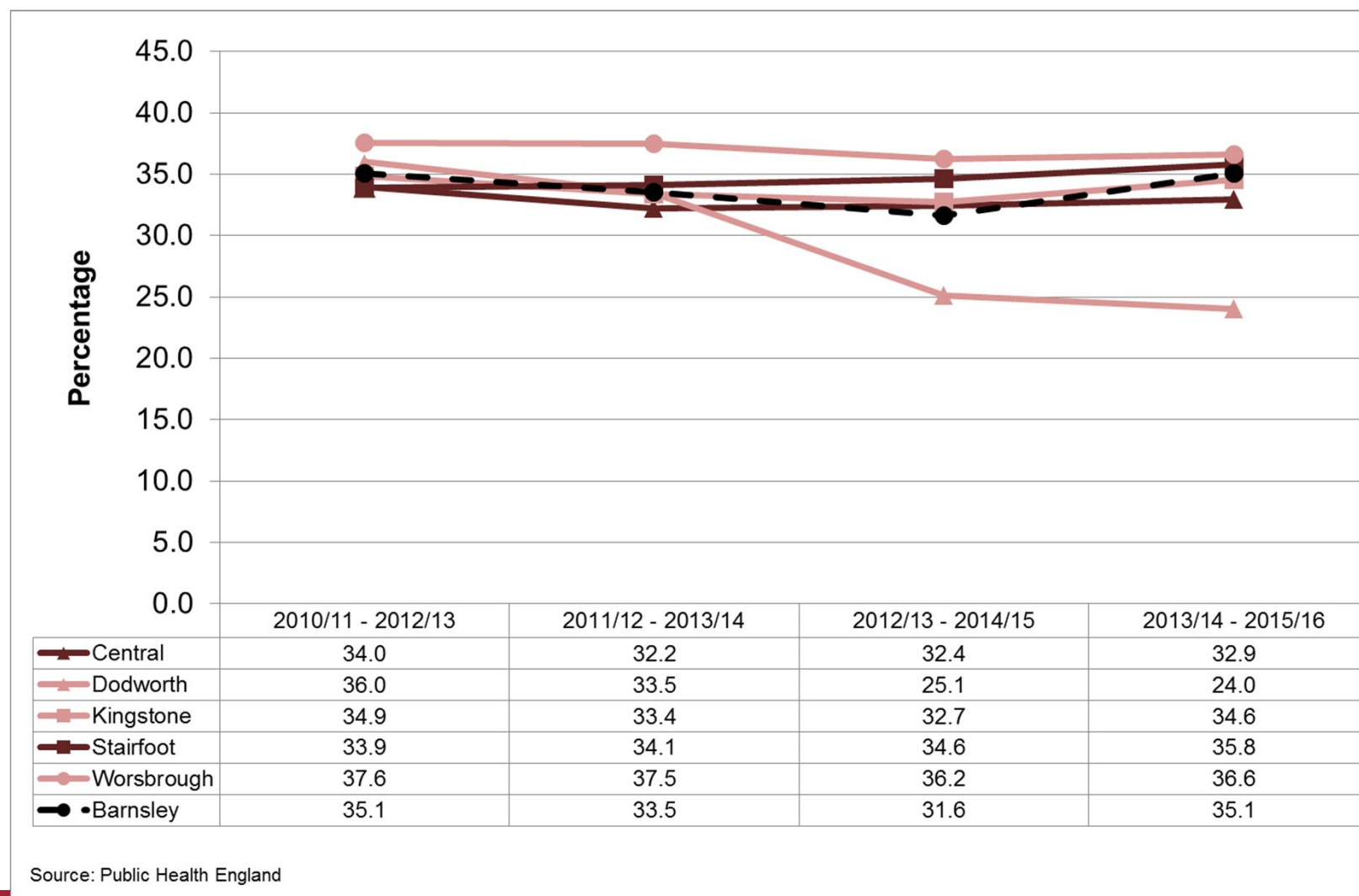




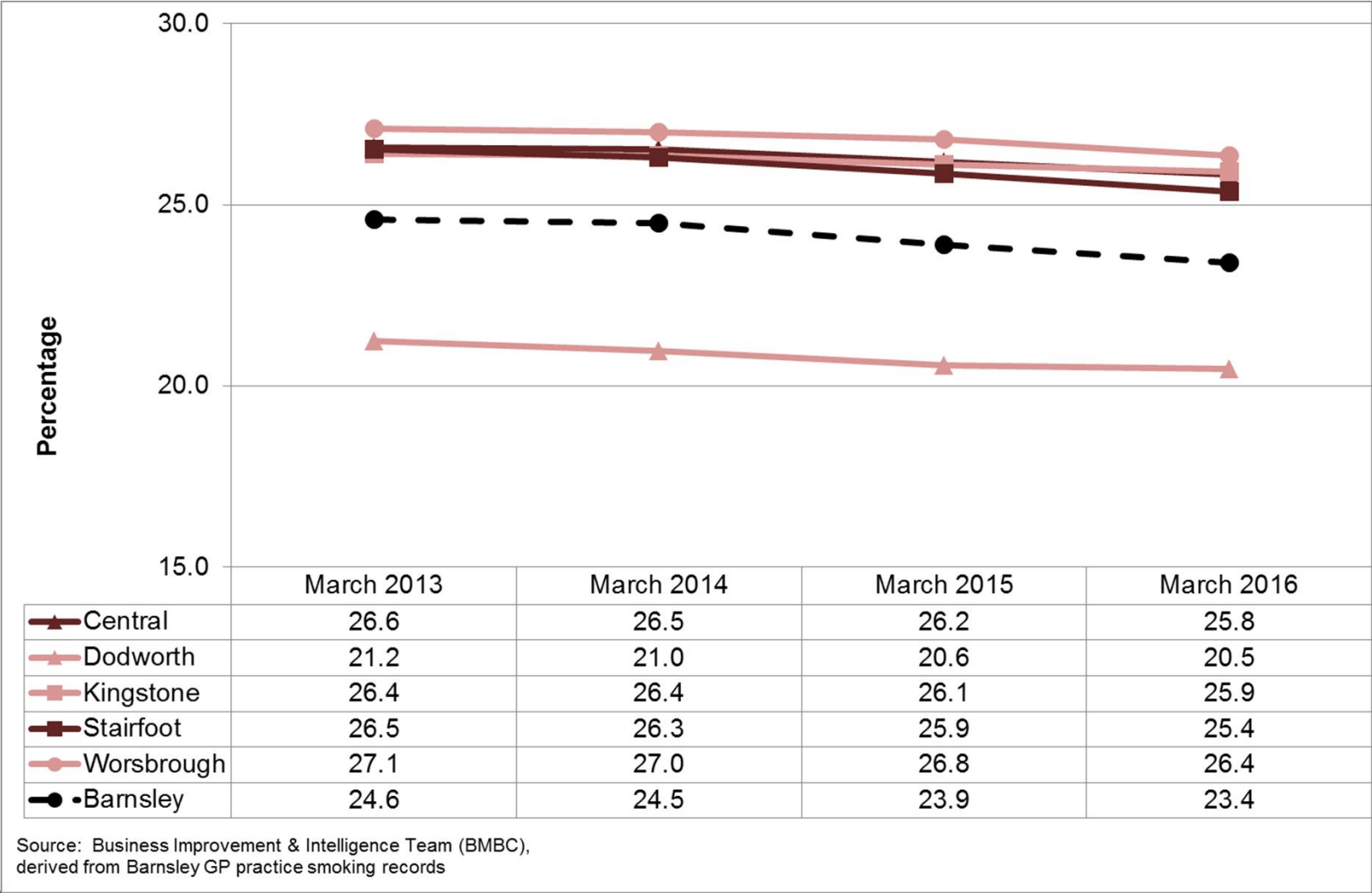

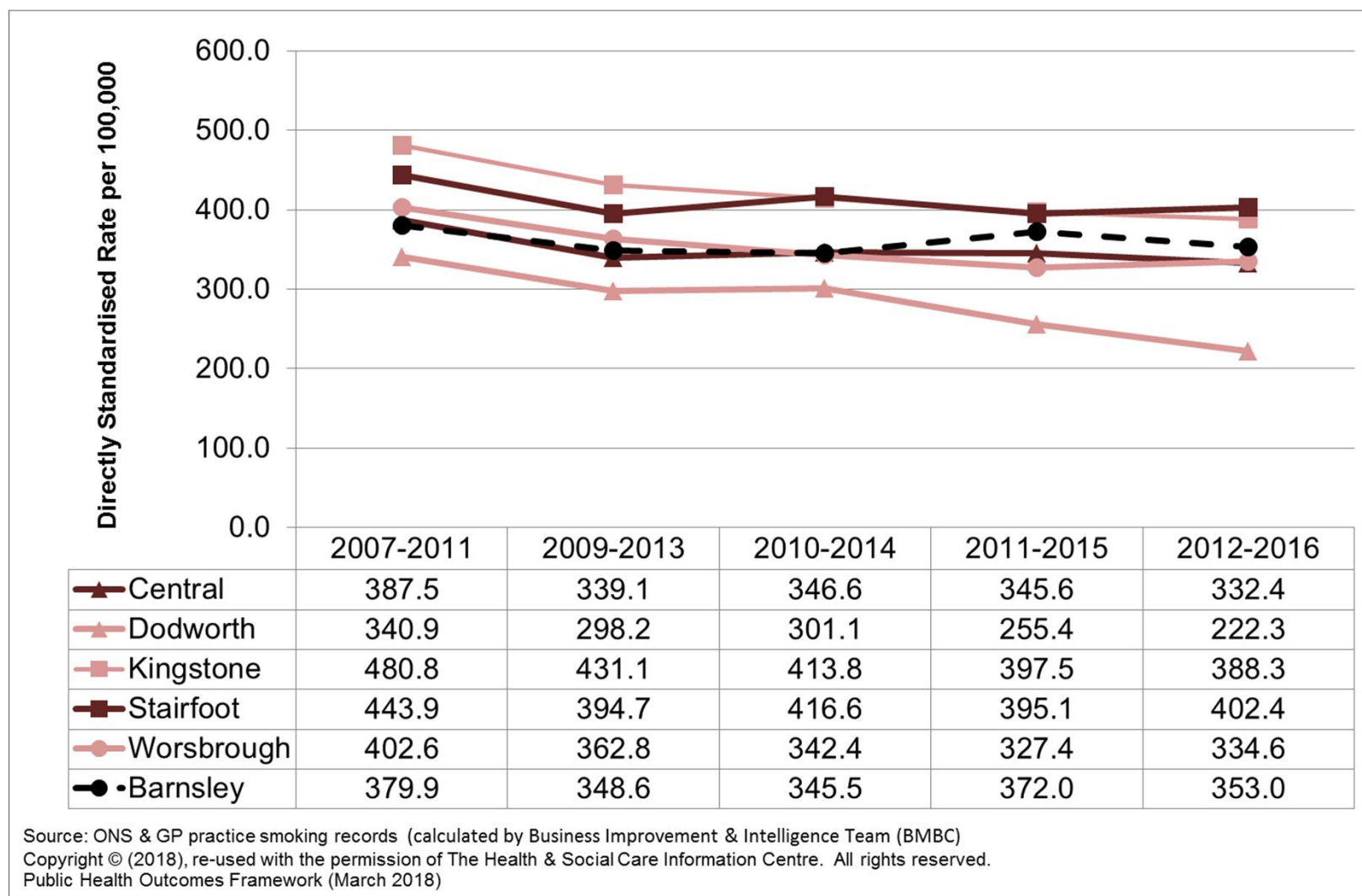


**Smoking prevalence (adults 18+)**

## Smoking related mortality (ages 35+)

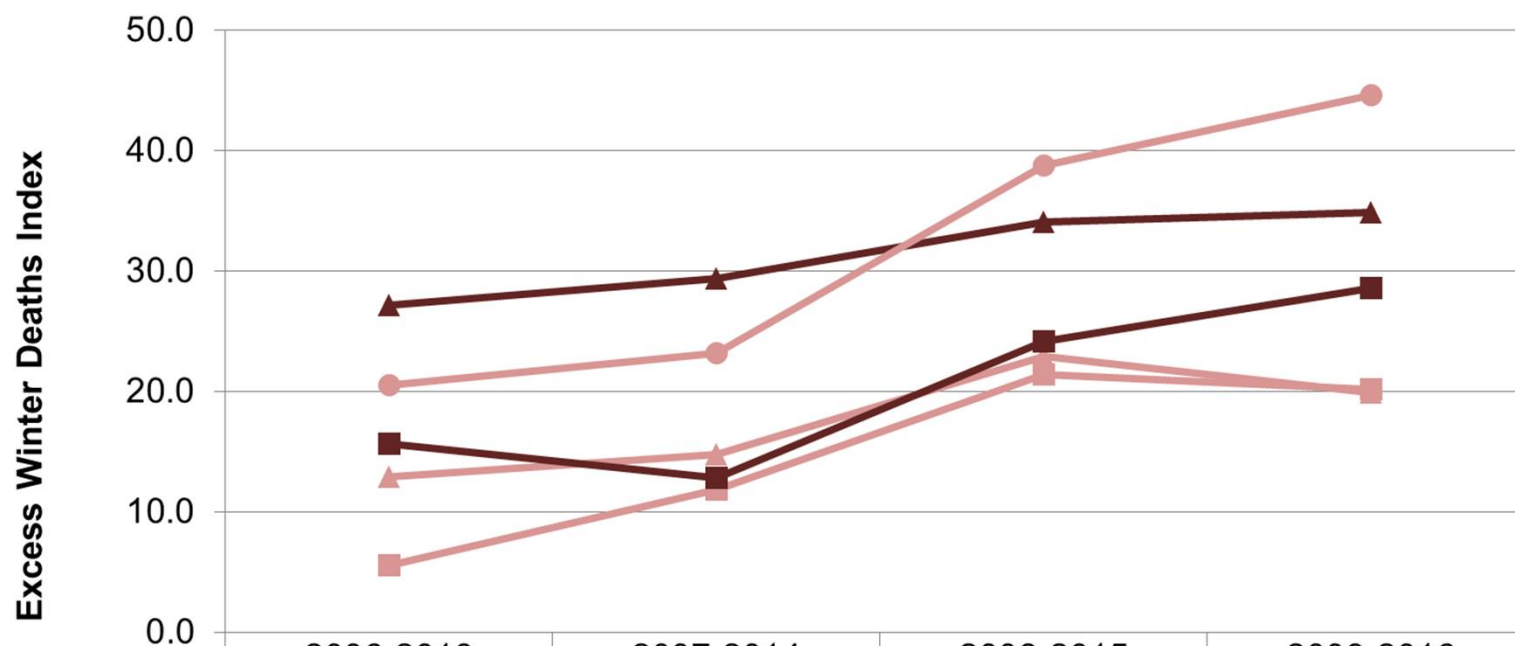

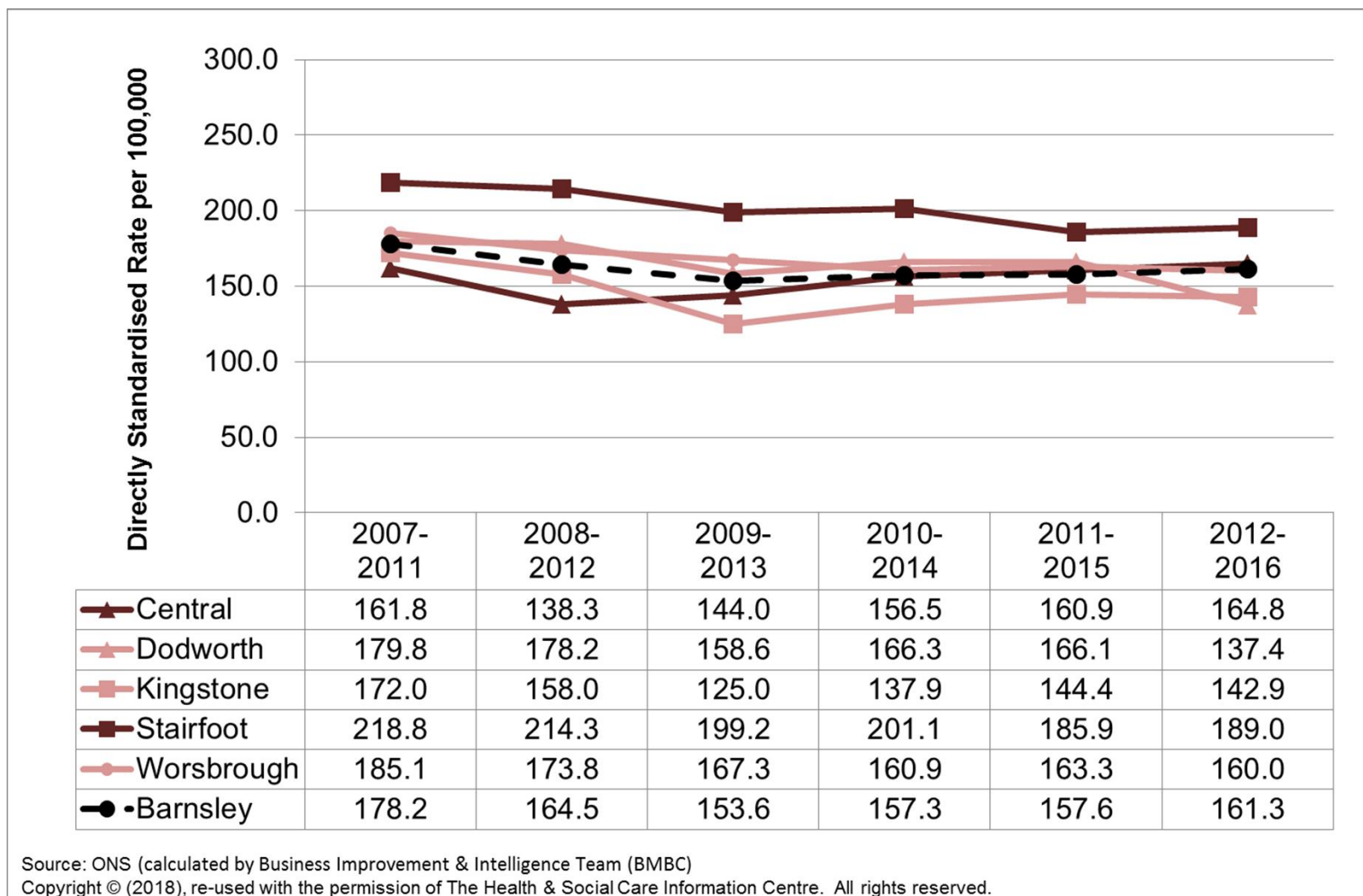

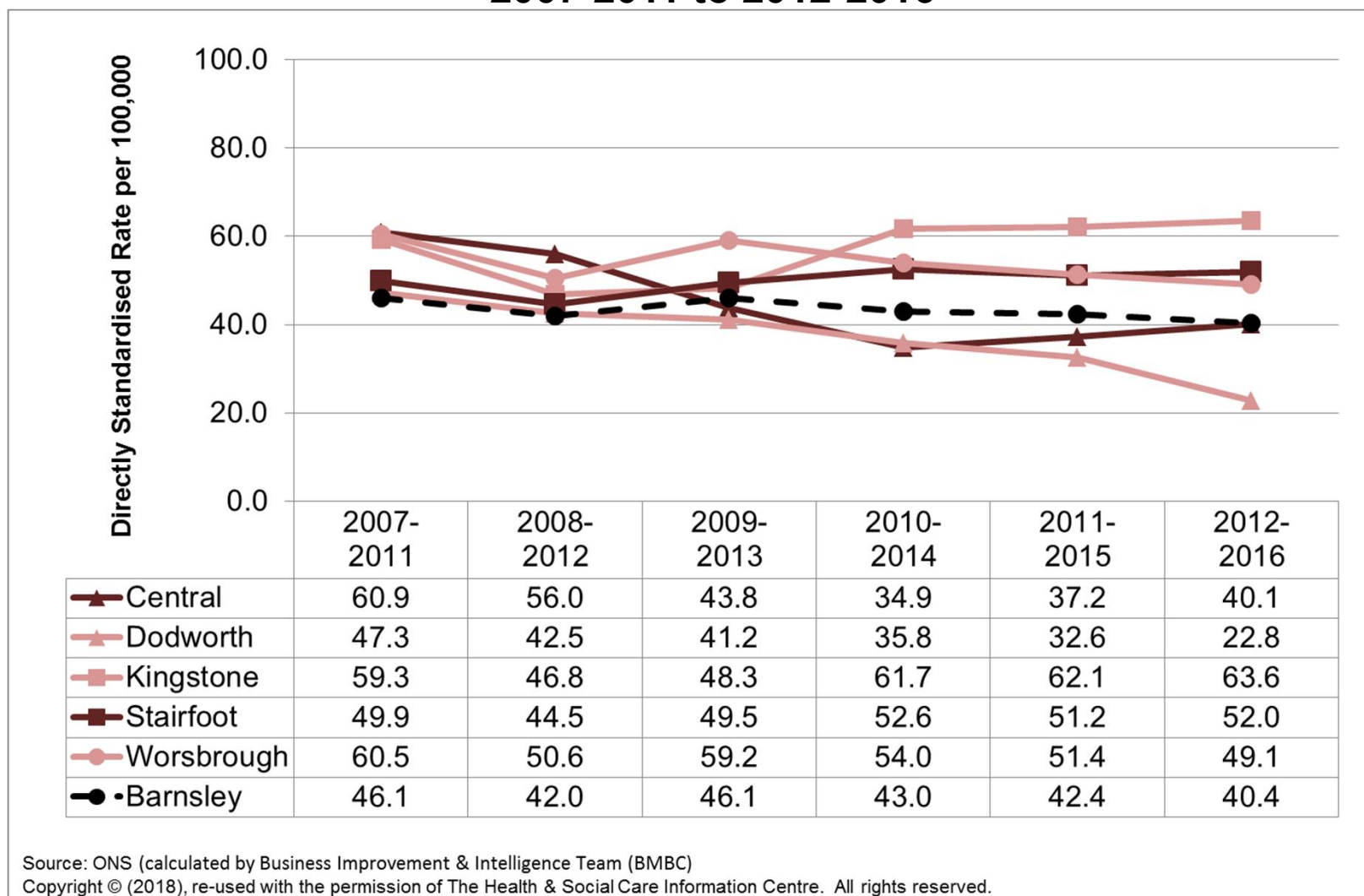
## Under 75 mortality from Cancer

### Central, Dodworth, Kingstone, Stairfoot and Worsbrough wards and Barnsley 2007-2011 to 2012-2016



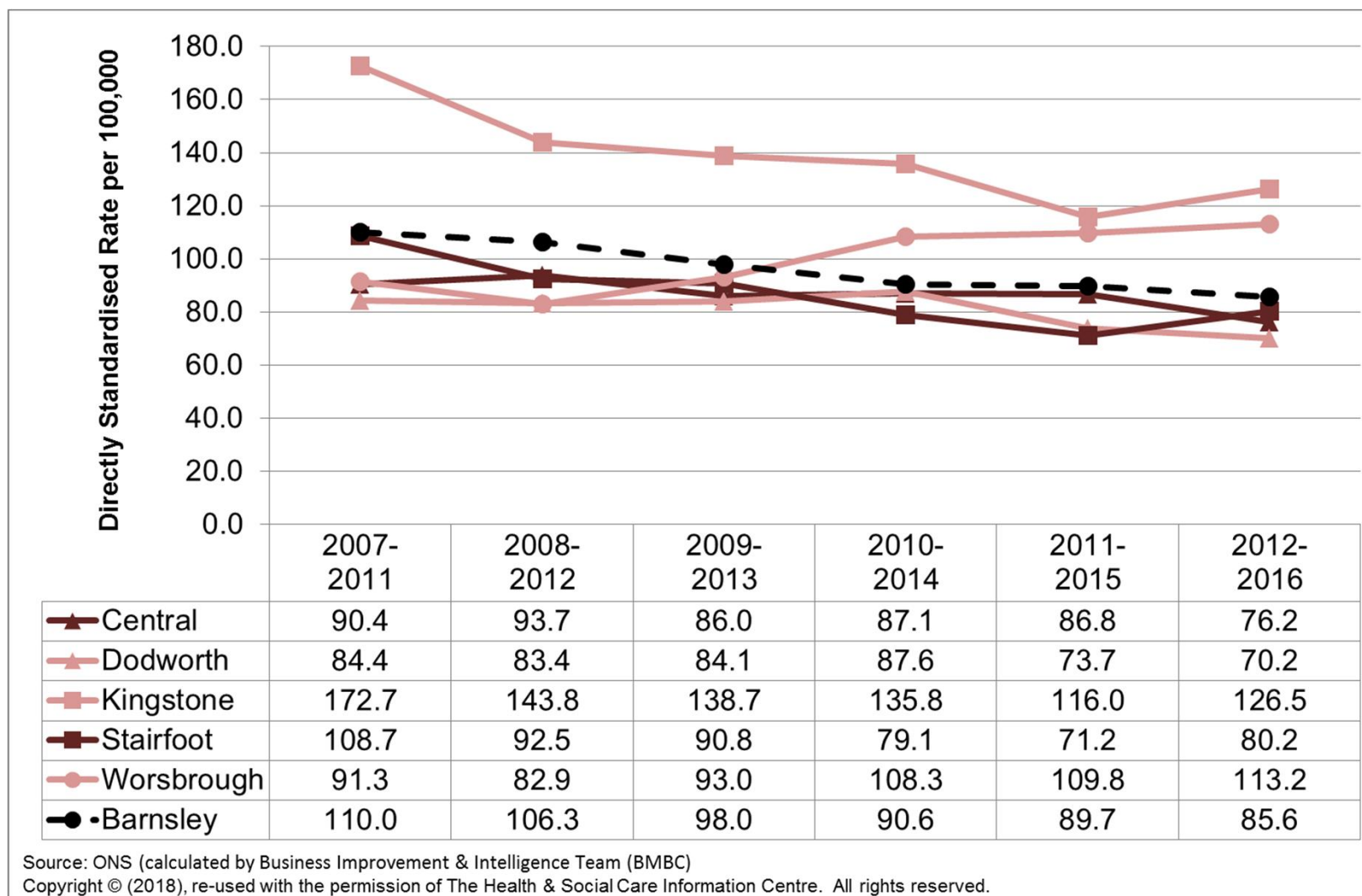

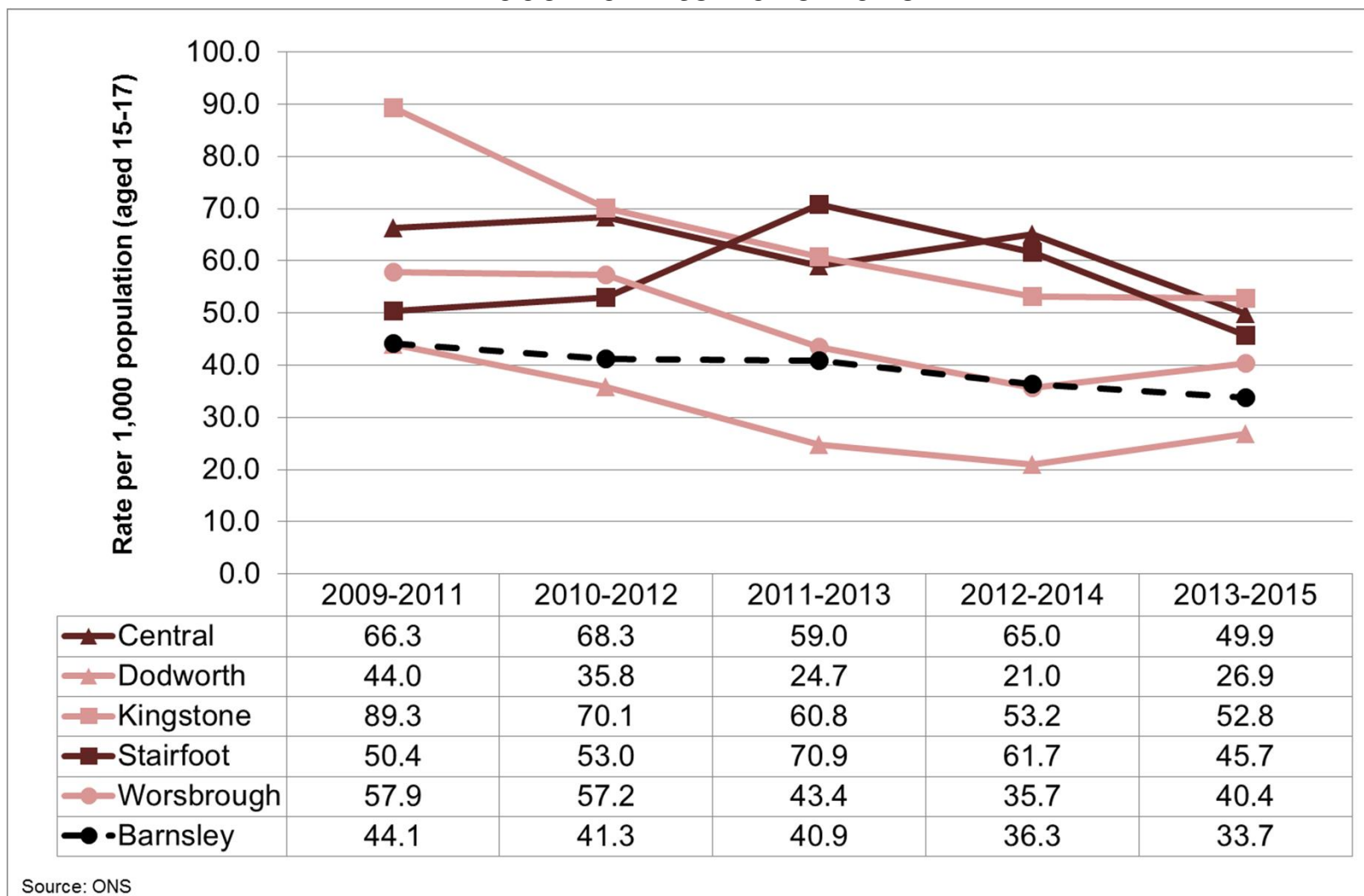

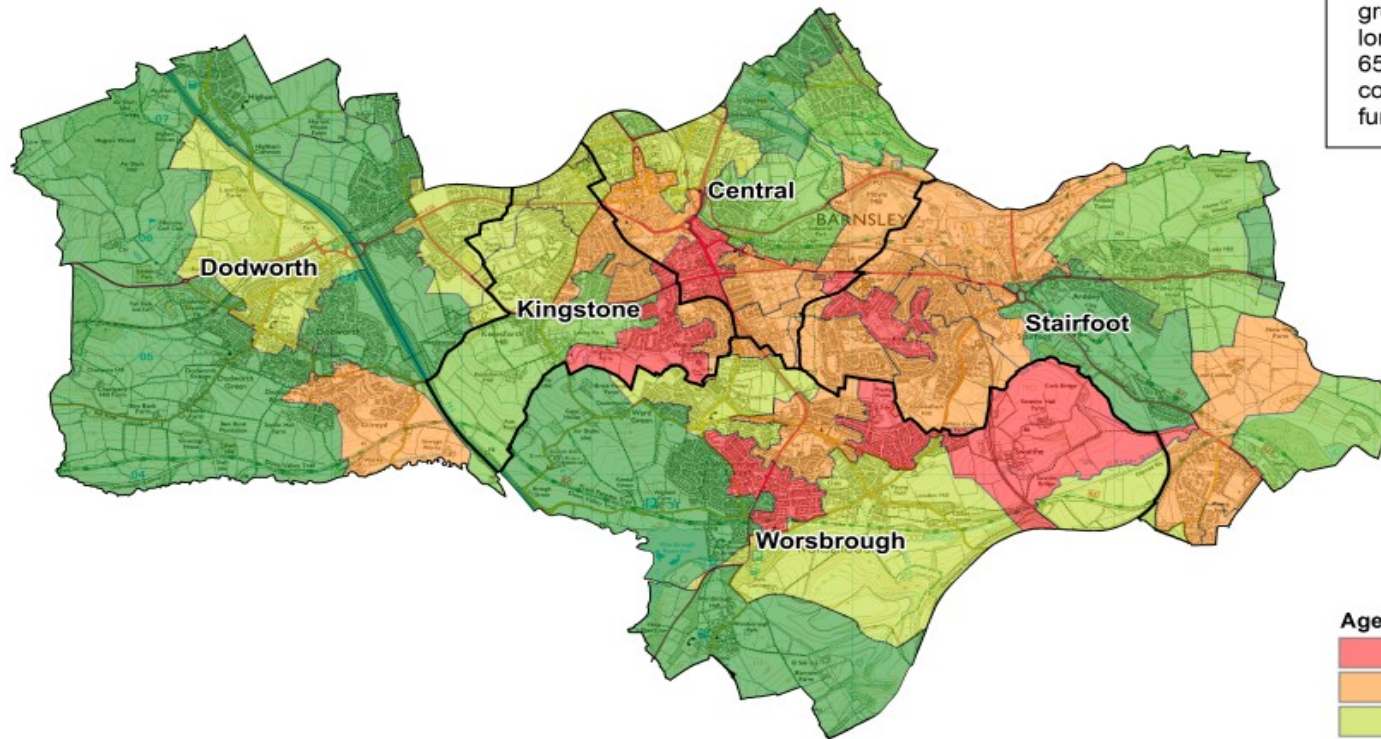
