









National Insurance Numbers (NINo)






% of Primary and Secondary pupils with English as an additional language (EAL) January 2017



Index of Multiple Deprivation 2015 Central Area Council LSOAs Relative to England (DCLG, 2015)



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











Education- Early Years Foundation Stage






Education-Year 1 Phonics Screening








Out of Work Benefits – Claimant Count

In February 2018:

- Central Area Council contained over 1,300 people claiming out of work benefits, this is 3.7% of the population aged 16 to 64 years.
- This rate is higher than Barnsley (3.1%) and England (2.0%)



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




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



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

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







Excess Winter Deaths Central, Dodworth, Kingstone, Stairfoot and Worsbrough wards 2006-2013 to 2009-2016




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




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

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Under 18 conceptions Central, Dodworth, Kingstone, Stairfoot and Worsbrough wards and Barnsley 2009-2011 to 2013-2015






Living Alone
