#### **Town Investment Plan Specifics**

- Interventions for up to £25 million
- The fund is 90% **capital**. Spend on tangible assets.
- Town Deals will cover a period of up to five years
- Should be a 'wrapper' for other investments, whether from other government departments or private investors.
- Will only support projects that are viable and sustainable in the long term, and which build on the town's assets and strengths.




