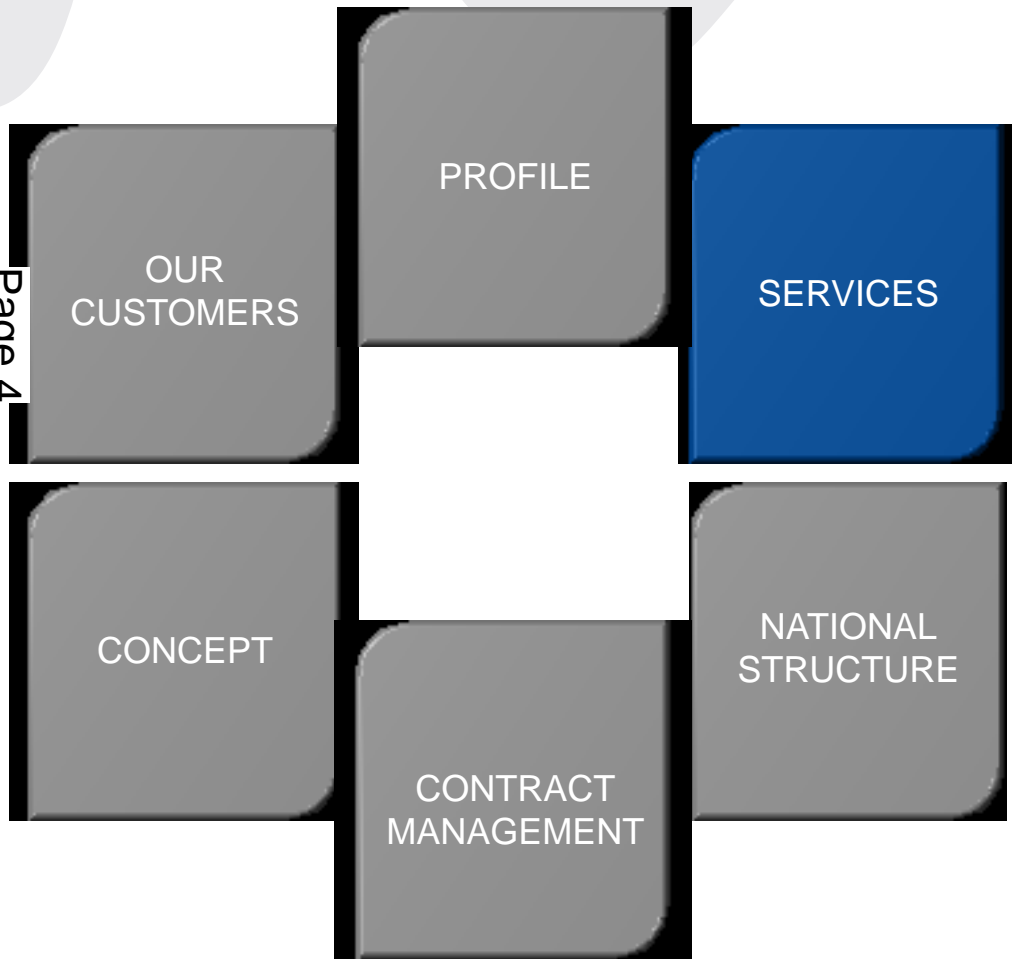

Implementation of Parking
Enforcement from April 01st 2022

To patrol the area`s of Wombwell,
Hoyland and Darfield within the South
Area of the Borough

An allocated level of hours agreed (18
hours per week)

Increased to 23 hours from July 2023 to
include School Patrols

Breakdown of Period & Attendance

75 Hours over a 15 Week Period

17 Schools attended

**64.5 Hours patrolled in attendance at the Schools
(92.14%)**

**5 Hours from Half term week attributed to normal
