7. Preparation for Adulthood (PfA) for children and young people with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND) (Cab.19.5.2021/7)

RESOLVED:-

The adoption of the Preparation for Adulthood Strategy 2021- 2022 be approved.

8. Barnsley Flood Recovery Report 2020/21 (Cab.19.5.2021/8)

RESOLVED:-

1. The flood recovery actions that have been taken to date and are planned for the next period be noted;
