Tenants First Service are helping promote MMIYP firstly we have introduced Tenant Support Champions who are specialists in key areas covering:


Discretionary - Water - Benefits Housing Payments (DHP) - Food _______ - Cost Of Living

More ways we are supporting MMIYP

Tenant Support Officers are also across the borough holding Money Advice Drop-in sessions along with the MMIYP at the new Warm & Welcoming Spaces Introduced by Barnsley Council to help residents with the cost of heating to attend these places to stay warm and get support and advice from a range of services these start from November.

These are to support those who prefer face to face support rather than over the phone or online we also have our Tenants First Achieve (ESF) advisors attending with us to help support tenants who are looking for work/ skills or training.

We still do offer home visits to our tenants. We are trailing our venues and areas could change full details here: <u>Money Advice</u> <u>Drop In</u>. We will be sending out rolling updates online via Twitter & Facebook updates on these.
