6.. Ward Alliance Finances

Current balances were confirmed as £17,929.98 Ward Alliance Fund, and £1,445.84 School's Out Fund.

The idea of coordinating a programme of holiday sporting provision utilising local sports clubs was discussed as an option for future spend of the Schools Out Fund. The fund has previously supported some sports clubs to deliver school holiday activity but there has been little take up of Schools Out since. This idea to be explored further. 7. Applications for Financial Assistance

Ward Alliance Funding:

Oxspring United JFC, £1607.04 – Full size goal posts

The club has significantly grown and offers a diverse mix of teams. A proposal for £1000 was recommended for approval.

Recognising an increase in the number of applications currently being received from sports clubs for equipment it was suggested that a list of potential sports specific funders be obtained which can be used by the Ward Alliance to direct groups accordingly. <u>Action</u>: Tanya

Wellbeing Craft Afternoon, £245 – Craft supplies

Although there were some concerns over the long-term viability of these classes, the Ward Alliance recognised the benefits for those attending. A proposal of £245 was recommend for approval with the offer of help in promoting the classes to the wider community to help increase numbers and its sustainability.

Thurlstone FC, £1,299.99 – Generator

There were several questions raised by Ward Alliance members. After discussion it was agreed to defer this application for a decision until further information was provided. <u>Action</u>: Tanya to liaise with the Club before bringing the application back to the September meeting.

Schools Out Fund:

Summer Sports Van, £1875

The decision to agree this application for funding ahead of the meeting was ratified.

8. Ward Alliance Projects

- **Summer school holiday provision in Penistone -** Week one of both the sports van and RampUP activities has gone well with good numbers attending the sessions.
- **Update on Ward Alliance branding** Penistone's request to be included within this piece of work has been submitted. Work is progressing steadily. Once further updates are available, these will be shared with the Ward Alliance.

The event will help us build up a picture as to what Penistone's food landscape currently looks like.
