

#### Why is the Programme so important?

Programme success has been acknowledged and it has been approved as a national screening initiative

#### Who is eligible?

People **aged 55-74 who have ever smoked** will be invited by letter and receive an appointment for a quick telephone call confirming eligibility

#### What is the process?

Once eligibility is confirmed, there are two steps involved in the process:

Step 1: A 30-minute telephone call with a Respiratory Nurse to assess a person's lung cancer risk (includes smoking cessation advice and a referral for support if welcomed)

Step 2: Those at higher risk are referred for a Low Dose CT scan











### **Doncaster outcomes**

As at 30 September 2023:

222 cancers have been found:

- 169 lung cancers
- 53 other cancers\*
  - 76% lung cancers found at an early stage
  - 74% of patients suitable for curative treatment





\*Breast, Urology, Haematology, Gastroenterology, Endocrinology, Dermatology, and unknown origin
