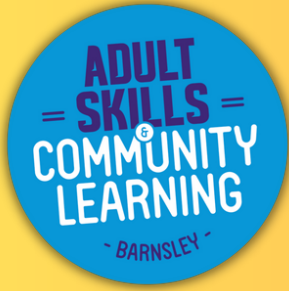

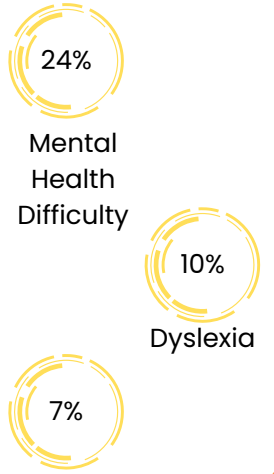

Ethnicity

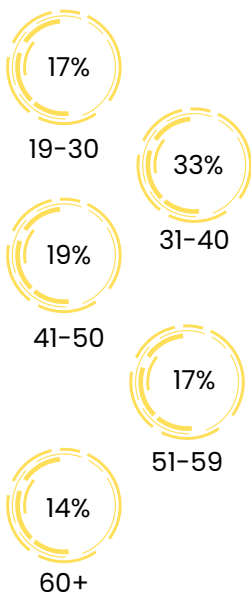


Health Condition
