People were invited to volunteer at the event to support engagement. We would look support other groups putting on events. • Artwork – The Ward Alliance have identified a number of boxes that we will now get permission for and start looking at material to out to ask people to come and create art on them. We will look at limiting the scope of what art can be created, to remove issue around political statements, but would encourage freedom of expression, and the group would like to invite some people to possible create their own style on this. • Environment – May 24th the Ward Alliance will be working with Twiggs to tidy up the area around New Beginnings Church on Ash Grove. A volunteer working around the Swanee has proposed we dye the water of the pond to kill the curly pond weed, this has been agreed to go ahead.
