### **1 Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence – Application Mr M K M**

The Panel was asked to determine a Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence for Mr M K M.

Mr M K M was in attendance at the meeting. After considering all the evidence presented and taking account of the manner in which Mr M K M had presented himself, together with the information provided and the representations made, the Panel determined that Mr M K M's Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence be suspended for a period of 30 days.

The decision of the Panel was unanimous.

### **2 Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence – Application Mr G F M**

The Panel was asked to determine a Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence for Mr G F M.

Mr G F M was not in attendance at the meeting. After considering all the evidence presented together with the information provided and the representations made, the Panel determined that Mr G F M's Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence be revoked.

### **1 Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence – Renewal Application Mr M P**

The Panel was asked to determine a renewal application for a Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence for Mr M P.

Mr M P was in attendance at the meeting together with R Taylor, Secretary of Barnsley Hackney Association and S Kilgariff, Vice Chair of Barnsley Hackney Association. After considering all the evidence presented and taking account of the manner in which Mr M P had presented himself, together with the information provided and the representations made, the Panel determined that Mr M P's renewal application for a Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence be approved as there was sufficient justification to warrant a deviation from the Council's suitability guidance.

Given that the safety of the public is paramount, the Panel determined that the licences be renewed (and for the operator and vehicle licences to continue), subject to the following:-

- Mr M P to undertake a DSA driving test within 3 months at his own expense.
- Mr M P be issued with a final written warning in relation to his conduct for breach of the licence conditions.

The decision of the Panel was unanimous.
