	<p><b>Brass on the Grass</b> the first session will be taking place Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> July. 2pm-3:45pm Volunteers will be needed to serve refreshments. <b>7. WAF Applications</b>			
	<p><b>Cudworth Crafters</b> have requested £548.99 for a new machine for the group. This has been approved.</p> <p><b>Youth Association</b> have requested £1283.00 to take four young people from Cudworth to London. This is part of the Street Voice initiative which will enable young people to have their voiced heard in relation to bullying at school and how schools deal with mental health issues. These young people have already been in the chambers at the Town Hall and aired their views to councillors and the Mayor. During the visit they will be visiting Westminster and then doing some sightseeing. Ward Alliance Members questioned the funding as this included remuneration for staff. JH asked if Christie (CDO) would come into the meeting and explain how Youth Workers are paid as Christie is from a youth background. The youth workers involved are taking this trip outside of work hours and are responsible for the young people on an overnight stay too. It was agreed that the WAF will be funded to the amount of £1199.00 this is the total of the breakdown of costs, on condition that the young people of Cudworth volunteer some time at one of our events or attends a meeting to do a presentation of the London trip.</p> <p><b>Whats Your Move?</b> This is an event that is taking place in Cudworth in the summer coinciding with the Olympic Games. There will be a wide range of sports providers demonstrating their sports with a view to getting more people into exercise. It was agreed to fund £1000.00 to facilitate some cultural demonstrations so that it would</p>
