Section 106 Allocations Wombwell Park Street Primary

1. Purpose of report

1.1 This report seeks approval for the allocation of Section 106 monies as set out in the recommendations section of this report.

2. Recommendations

2.1 It is recommended that:

 £160,319.49 of S106 monies are allocated towards the increase of capacity of Wombwell Park Street Primary school providing Additional school places for the Wombwell Area.

3. Introduction

- 3.1 This report relates to education monies totalling £160,319.49 received through planning permission 2013/0866 (Barnsley Road, Wombwell). The spend conditions of the legal agreement are defined as:
 - "...towards the provision of and/or improvement to primary school educational facilities within Wombwell the need for which directly arises from the development."
- 3.2 The proposals contained in this report relate to the works which will enhance the primary school offer within Wombwell and are therefore deemed to be compliant with the conditions of the legal agreement.
- 3.3 The proposals contained within this report are also deemed to be compliant with the CIL Regulations to be adopted 1st April 2015 where no more than 5 legal agreements can be pooled to fund site infrastructure. S106 allocations to the site contained within this report on or after 6th April 2010 are shown in Appendix B of this report.

4. Consideration of alternative approaches

4.1 This report has been prepared within the agreed protocols established for the progression of S106 related projects within the Council.

5. Proposal and justification

5.1 £160,319.49 of S106 monies are allocated towards the development to increase the Pupil Admission Number (PAN) at Wombwell Park Street Primary

- from 30 to 45 (per year group). By carrying out this work an additional 105 primary school places will be created in Wombwell.
- 5.2 Wombwell Park Street Primary is a PFI (Private Finance Initiative) school that opened in September 2007. In order to increase capacity it is necessary to provide 3 additional classrooms. This will be done through internal remodelling and a new single class extension.
- 5.4 The scheme started on site in April 2016, and was completed in September 2016.
- 5.5 The project costs for developing Wombwell Park Street Primary was £1.013m and was funded through the Basic Need Capital Grant.
- 5.6 By allocation of \$106 monies, currently constrained to the Wombwell Area, £160,319.49 Basic Need funding will be released to provide additional school places across the borough.

6. <u>Implications for local people / service users</u>

6.1 The proposals contained within this document will deliver benefits for local people by increasing the number of primary school places, on offer, within the Wombwell area.

7. Financial implications

- 7.1 Consultations on the financial implications have taken place with representatives of the Director of Finance, Property & Information Services.
- 7.2 Section 106 monies totalling £160,319.49 are available to fund the provision of the scheme identified within this report.
- 7.3 Expenditure identified within this scheme will be managed within the resources available.
- 7.4 The financial implications relating to this proposal are shown in Appendix A of this document.

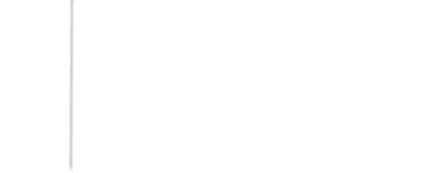
