



## Barnsley Libraries Engagement Feedback

### Introduction

As an extension of conversations we had in 2016 a number of surveys were designed to capture the views of public and members of library staff to help shape the future of Barnsley's library service. The surveys were open during between October 2017 and March 2018 and promoted via the BMBC website and in libraries themselves.

In conjunction with the surveys we also held events with community groups and partners in each library area to design the future libraries model.

Additionally we also monitored comments made on Twitter and Facebook using the hashtag #LetsTalkLibraries.

### Survey Findings

#### Staff Survey

This survey was designed to ask those who work in libraries across Barnsley their preferred options to make the required library service savings of £165,000 per year.

#### Staff Survey Key Findings

- A total of 54 responses were received from those who worked at Libraries across Barnsley, the majority of respondents (25.9%) mainly work at Central library, followed by Wombwell (13.0%) and Royston (11.1%).
- 61.1% of those surveyed had a preference for reducing current library opening hours as a way to make the desired savings.
- 31.5% of respondents provided free text comments with regards to their preferred savings option. All free text comments were coded into themes. The majority of comments 41.2% related to opening hours. A copy of the coding structure is provided at appendix A.
- Demographic questions were not asked as part of this survey.

## Events – Delegate Responses

A series of events were held at libraries at which attendees were asked to fill in an online survey. The survey asked respondents to identify the library they used most frequently and identify their preferred options to make the required library service savings of £165,000 per year.

### Delegate Responses Key Findings

- A total of 157 responses were received from those who attended events at libraries across Barnsley, this represents 0.08% of the Barnsley population aged 16 years +.
- Barnsley Wards were derived from respondent's postcodes and each question has been analysed based on preferred Library branch.
- It was not possible to derive wards for 12 respondents; this was due to a variety of reasons, including incomplete or unrecognised postcodes and postcodes out of the Barnsley area.
- The majority of respondents (10.8%) provided a postcode in Darfield ward, followed by Dearne South (7.6%) and Royston (7.0%).
- Respondents used Central (14.0%) and Goldthorpe (14.0%) libraries the most, followed by Wombwell (10.8%).
- 50.0% of respondents had a preference for reducing current library opening hours as a way to make the desired savings.
- The least favoured option for making savings was conversion to a Community Managed Library in another location (shared building) with only 2.0% of respondents favouring this option.
- 46.5% of respondents provided free text comments with regards to their preferred savings option. All free text comments were coded into themes. The majority of comments 30.1% related to opening hours. A copy of the coding structure is provided at appendix A.

### Delegate Responses Demographic Data

The majority of respondents;

- Were female (57.8%)
- Aged 65-74 years (40.0%)
- British (98.1%)
- Did not consider themselves as disabled (84.0%)

### Mosaic Analysis

Mosaic is a Customer Insight tool which uses socio-demographic segmentation to classify all households and postcodes to comprehensively describe their social, economic and cultural behaviour. Segmentation is the classification of the population in different groups; it is an approach for providing services based on an understanding of local populations and neighbourhood context. Further detail can be found in the Libraries Needs Assessment.

The diagram below shows how the Mosaic groups from Delegate Survey Respondents compare with the Barnsley average. Bars to the right of the central line illustrate a higher proportion of households than the Barnsley average and conversely a lower proportion to the left. The proportion of Delegate Survey Respondents in Groups A Country Living, E Suburban Stability, F Senior Security and K Modest Traditions are particularly overrepresented, whilst Groups I Urban Cohesion and J Rental Hubs are underrepresented with no respondents from these groups. In Barnsley there are no households in Group C City Prosperity.

## Engagement Responses

This online survey was open to all and sought views on whether the criteria considered to shape the future library service were suitable. Additionally we gave space for further criteria to be suggested.

### Key Findings

- A total of 163 responses were received which represents 0.08% of the Barnsley population aged 16 years +.
- Barnsley Wards were derived from respondent's postcodes and each question has been analysed based on ward and most used Library branch.
- It was not possible to derive wards for 16 respondents; this was due to a variety of reasons, including incomplete or unrecognised postcode and postcode out of the Barnsley area.
- Two respondents said they did not have a Library branch they used most often and one respondent did not fill out this survey field.
- The majority of respondents (16.0%) provided a postcode in Darfield ward, followed by Darton East (9.9%) and unknown or unrecognised postcodes (9.3%).
- 21.0% of respondents were most likely to use central library, followed by Darfield (17.3%).
- The majority of respondents (93.7%) felt library usage was a suitable factor when choosing the criteria to shape the future library, followed by meeting community need (95.0%).
- Overall there was strong agreement that all of the listed factors were suitable when choosing the criteria to shape the future library with at least 71.2% of respondents agreeing with each of the listed factors; library usage (93.7%), patterns of demand (87.0%), building implications (83.6%), ability to collaborate with other organisations and integrate with other organisations (78.3%), travel time for users and geographic coverage (88.4%), meeting community need (95.0%), how long and how complex it would be to deliver the changes (71.2%).
- If respondents did not agree with the suggested factors they were given the opportunity to explain why, of the free text responses suggested the majority were coded under the theme of 'other'.
- Respondents were asked if there was anything else they thought should be included in the criteria. Free text responses were coded and the majority of comments (49.0%) related to community need.
- Thinking about the library they use most often respondents were given the opportunity to suggest anything that they felt should be considered about this library.
- Of the free text comments received 25.6% relate to staff, followed by 22.5% relating to community need and 24.8% facilities. A copy of the coding structure is provided at appendix A


The majority of respondents;

- Were English/ Welsh/ Scottish/ Northern Irish/ British (90.4%)
- Were heterosexual (78.1%)
- Were Christian (63.4%)
- Did not consider themselves as disabled (83.0%)

### Mosaic Analysis

The diagram below shows how the Mosaic groups from Engagement Survey Respondents compare with the Barnsley average. Bars to the right of the central line illustrate a higher proportion of households than the Barnsley average and conversely a lower proportion to the left. The proportion of Engagement Survey Respondents in Groups D Domestic Success and F Senior Security are particularly overrepresented, whilst

group I Urban Cohesion had no respondents from this group. Groups M Family Basics, N Vintage Value and O Municipal Challenge are particularly underrepresented. In Barnsley there are no households in group C City Prosperity.

Attendee feedback from each of the library events is included at appendix B. Attendees of the library events were also asked to fill out online surveys (see Events - Delegate Responses page 3). One of the online survey questions required respondents to select which of Barnsley libraries they used the most. 17.2% of respondents highlighted their most used library differed from the library at which they attended an event.

### Summary

Care should be taken when interpreting these results due to the low number of responses which represent a very small percentage of Barnsley's population.

Based on staff survey and events delegate feedback the most popular method of achieving required savings is reduce opening hours.

Results from the engagement survey show broad agreement with the suitability of proposed factors for shaping the future library service. The most popular factor was meeting community need, closely followed by library usage.
