Subject

Due to the statutory duties around the homeless legislation there is a need to place people into temporary accommodation; this is usually the Earl Marshall in Sheffield. Before a placement is made all other options are explored. Work is ongoing to reduce the use of B&B, especially out of area. This is the only hotel, local to Barnsley, who will accept referrals form the Housing Options Team. The market for this provision is very limited.
