Record of Decision of the Executive Director of Communities Wendy Lowder  
in respect of the contract for a Library Management System

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### Subject

The existing contract for the Library Management System (LMS) terminates on 31 March 2020. The purpose of this report is to seek authorisation for Barnsley Library service to take advantage of the new contract arrangements secured by the Yorkshire Book Consortium's tender exercise.

It was recognised by the YBC which includes 15 Authorities in the Yorkshire and Humber Region: Barnsley, Bradford, Calderdale, Doncaster, East Riding, Hull, Kirklees, Leeds, North Lincolnshire, N.E. Lincolnshire, North Yorkshire, Rotherham, Sheffield, Wakefield and York, that entering into a competitive process for the provision of a LMS system/services would deliver improved services and savings. It was agreed that a single supplier Framework Agreement would be pursued.

The procurement exercise was carried out under the Public Contract Regulations 2015 and resulted in the award of a single supplier Framework Agreement for the supply of a "Cloud Hosted" Library Management System and associated support services. The Consortia awarded the Framework Agreement to Sirsi Dynix. The Framework Agreement covers a 4 year period with the option to extend annually up to 5 single years after this.

### Authority

This will be under the authorisation of Wendy Lowder Executive Director of Communities.

### Decision Taken

It is recommended that the contract for the LMS be awarded to Sirsi Dynix as a Call Off under the LMS Consortium Framework Agreement.
