<u>Subject</u>

The Local Welfare Assistance Scheme (LWA) provides a limited range of household goods to assist vulnerable people in genuine need to live safely in the community. The current scheme is undergoing a review to determine what if any provision the Council should provide in this area in the future. The review was due to be completed by the end of the financial year. This has however been delayed and it is now hoped to complete the review and make recommendations in spring/summer.

Unfortunately, the scheme's existing supplier of goods will cease trading in mid-March. This will mean the scheme will be unable to function. There is therefore a need to make a short-term arrangement that will allow the scheme to continue to function until a decision in made about the future of the scheme. The procurement exercise would be undertaken at this stage if relevant.
