Birk Avenue, Kendray

Birk Avenue in Kendray, part of the Stairfoot Ward and its adjoining streets are one of the main walk ways for the public around the area, as it has school and shop in close proximity, as well as having a large park area. This particular area was therefore brought to our attention by complaints received through the local council neighbourhood services, the local councillors and also from our officers, who noticed the amount of litter and dog fouling on the street during their routine patrols.



Over the quarter our District officers have patrolled the area on a regular basis and at different times of the day. The officers were able to identify some of the offenders and issue 8 x FPN's to those who dropped their litter on the streets.

Our officers have renewed/placed stickers and signage in the area, the feedback has been good and, our officers will continue their patrols in this area.

It should also be noted that District is now working with BMBC providing Covid Marshal's for the Barnsley Area. The Marshal's have been seen out patrolling the Central area since November, reporting back to the council any Covid compliance breeches, as well as gatherings which take place against the current regulations in force at the time.
