Notice under Regulation 10: Key Decision where less than 28 days' public notice has been given

Pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ('the Regulations'), I hereby give Notice that:-

The **Cabinet** intends to make a Key Decision on behalf of Barnsley MBC on **23/3/22** regarding **Additional funding for Parkside Development, Hoyland.**

It has not been possible to give 28 clear days' notice of the intention to make the Key Decision. The reasons why compliance is impracticable in this matter are as follows:-

Additional funding is required to realise the requirements to provide an equivalent facility at Parkside Hoyland which is being relocated from the current forge partnership site.

As part of this development a funding application to the football foundation is being made

The timetable for submission of an application to the football foundation is early June. A fully designed and costed scheme is required to be part of that submission therefore work needs to start in early April to meet this timescale. Work cannot start on the design and costing of the project until funding is secured.
